### **Knitting Rules:**

- 1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
- 2. **All entries must be registered by Friday, July 11, 2025.** Entries that are not registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page at <a href="https://www.ecfair.org">www.ecfair.org</a>.
- 3. Articles will be judged on the following: overall appearance, design, harmony of color, workmanship, quality of materials used (no loose ends on the inside of the garment), finishing and originality.
- 4. The condition of the article must be clean, properly blocked and not noticeably worn. Soiled articles will not be judged. Articles are to be the work of the exhibitor.
- 5. **PLEASE NOTE: In describing categories:** An article with a contrasting design refers to a color design. An article with pattern stitch refers to a design in the stitch itself such as lace, cables, basket stitch, etc. Unless otherwise indicated, articles may be either hand knitted or crocheted.
- 6. All entries must be clean and free of dirt, pet hair and stains.
- 7. Please no name labels.
