- Payment appreciated day of sale or by invoice.
- Payment methods accepted include cash, check, credit card (fees apply)
- Add-on support money will be accepted online beginning Sept 14th, at the sale office sale day or up to 7 days after close of sale.
- Buyer pays all slaughter/processing fees

# HOW TO SUPPORT

- **Purchase/Keep** option—buyer pays final price per lb x animal weight; take home live or make arrangements with, and directly pay, a local packer for slaughter and processing. Visit our sale web page for packer directory.
- **Turn/Re-Sale** option—select to resell the animal at floor price. You pay the difference between final auction price and floor price. Buyer does not take ownership or receive meat.
- **“Add-On”**—add a specified dollar amount of support onto any 4-H or FFA sale participant. Online Add Ons open day of sale.
- **Sale Sponsorship**—make a monetary donation to help offset sale expenses.
