EMERGENCY PLAN Lazy E Arena, Guthrie OK

EVENT: NLBRA Finals

MEDICAL EMERGENCY:

With EMT on site: Identify the nature of the injury or illness. Contact Dan Wall, Sammi Miller or Stacy Starr for the EMT on duty apprising them of suspected injury or illness and location of patient. Allow EMT to make a decision of appropriate action after examination.

FIRE, LAW ENFORCEMENT:

Do not attempt to control any situations. Call 911 immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR 911:

State the nature of the emergency: Medical, Fire or Law Enforcement

State the Emergency is at the <u>Lazy E ARENA</u> (do not use "ranch"). Specific buildings are identified and kept at Woodcrest Fire Department and Logan County Sheriff Departments. Identify the building or area where the emergency is located. Request that lights and sirens are off upon entering the main gate.

Notify a Lazy E representative, familiar with the facility, to meet EMS/Law Enforcement agencies at the main gate to send them specifically to the emergency location. Assist them in keeping the area clear of bystanders and unnecessary personnel.

Should EMS/Law Enforcement decide it is in the best interest of the patient to respond with a medical helicopter, please ask they utilize the designated medical heliport to avoid further accidents and expedite transport. All responding medical helicopters have the Lazy E Arena GPS coordinates for the helipad.

INCLEMENT WEATHER:

Be weather aware. The Lazy E Arena is located at the crossroads of Forest Hills Rd and Douglas Rd – Guthrie, OK. Often referred to as Southern Logan County EAST of I-35. Most local TV (Channels 4, 5, 9 & 25) have Lazy E Arena identified as a town on their weather maps. Local radio stations that interrupt programing for weather alerts are 100.5, 101.9, 98.9, 104.1 and 102.7. Most carry the weather reports from the TV stations.

People's safety is the highest priority. Horses need to remain in their stalls or current locations regardless of the weather emergency. Horses that have been hauled in for the day can be tied-out inside the performance arena.

In the case of tornadic activity:

People will be the priority. Horses will remain where they are under cover in their stalls or tied-out in the performance area of the Main Arena. People should utilize areas located in the concourse – bathrooms, stairwells, storage areas and offices (without outside windows). Should these areas not provide enough room for people occupancy, concourse areas between the glass doors are the next best option. These areas have reinforced concrete walls with overhead bleacher or stairwell ceilings made of reinforced concrete. The performance arena (dirt floor area) is not the best place to be in the case of a tornado.
