# WALKER COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION LITTLE TYKES RODEO RULES

#### STICK HORSE BARREL RACING / ages 3-5 years & 6-8 years

Contestant may use their own stick horse or borrow one from the committee This is a timed event. Contestant will run around all three barrels for a time Rodeo Judge's decision is final. 1st place winner receives trophy; 2nd & 3rd place will receive ribbons in each age.

### Bouncy Bull Riding / ages 3-5 years

Contestant will ride the Bouncy Bucking bull for a score. One ride per contestant. Rodeo Judge's decision is final. 1st place winner receives trophy; 2nd & 3rd place will receive ribbons in each age.

# Goat Ribbon Pulling / ages 3-5 years & 6-8 years

This event will be done on foot. This is a timed event. Contestant will run from starting line, pull ribbon from a staked goat and return to start line. Rodeo judge's decision is final. 1st place winner receives trophy; 2nd & 3rd place will receive ribbons in each age.

### Dummy Roping / ages 3-5 years & 6-8 years

Contestants will each have 3 opportunities to try and rope a dummy steer. Three legal head catches. Head catches must be legal or will not count. Contestant must stand behind clearly established barrier line to throw loop. Stepping over the line before the try is completed will be considered a missed try. Contestant will be expected to step to the barrier line and be ready to compete when called. Rodeo Judge's decision is final.

1st place winner receives trophy; 2nd & 3rd place will receive ribbons in each age.

#### Steer Wrestling / ages 6-8 years

Timed event.

Contestants shall run from marked start line to the steer while riding stick horse. Contestant shall use one hand to knock steer over onto its side of the arena dirt. Time stops when steer form touches the ground. Rodeo Judge's decision is final. 1st place winner receives trophy; 2nd & 3rd place will receive ribbons in each age.

#### **BEST DRESSED STICK HORSE all ages**

Consideration for the best decorated includes both contestant and stick horse. Contestant's stick horse should be decorated. (Suggestions: Use of paint, ribbons, stickers, fabric, fur, feathers, buttons, etc.) 1st place winner receives trophy Rodeo judge's decision is final.
