

Welcome Back - Finally!

In less than three weeks, fair folks from across the state will meet in South Portland at the Sheraton at Sable Oaks for the 2022 Maine Association of Agricultural Fairs annual conference. I am pleased to share with you a preview of some of our workshops, organizational meetings and so much more.

On Friday, registration is open from 12-1:15 PM, and then 4:00-5:00 PM. The Marketplace will be open Friday afternoon from 1:00-5:00 PM. Our MAAF General Session will reconvene at 2:30 PM. Friday night dinner is on your own. Friday evening at 7:00 PM I invite you to join in our MAAF auction. There will be something offered for everyone's taste and pocketbook! At 8:00 PM we welcome back a fair favorite as Sharon Hood & Dixon Road entertain us with a mix of modern country and classic rock.

Saturday begins with a Breakfast buffet from 6:30-8:00 AM. The Fair Presidents' Breakfast meeting will be held from 7:30-8:45 AM. Registration is open from 8:00-12 PM. The Marketplace will open at 9:00 AM and close at 3:00 PM. Conference opening remarks are offered at 9AM, and the first workshop begins at 9:30 AM. Our 2019 Maine Agriculture Teacher of the Year, Lynn Anderson-Snow, will open the conference with a program "Agriculture Education For All." Her remarks are designed to help fairs learn the steps for how to teach your fair goers about agriculture. Organizational group meetings will be scheduled concurrently.

Lunch will be available in the courtyard in a taste-tempting selection of food trucks. Open for business will be Ye Olde English Fish and Chips from Richmond and Fat Guys from Cumberland. Plus some newcomers!

The afternoon workshop , starting at 1:30 PM, is titled: "Volunteers: How To Get Them...How To Keep Them." Once again, there will be other meetings occurring concurrently.
