#### Mural Competition Rules:

- 1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
- 2. Anyone over 18 years old is eligible to apply to enter this contest.
- 3. Artists will create their work on a 4' x 6' panels provided by the Erie County Fair. Designs must be done horizontally.
- 4. Entries limited. You must apply to participate via email by <u>May 1, 2025.</u> Applicants must present at least two (2) photo samples of your work and provide a brief biography about themselves. A panel will review each artist's submission to approve your application to participate.
- 5. Chosen artists will be contacted with further instructions by May 31, 2025.
- 6. All entered murals will be on display during the 12 days of the Erie County Fair. They will be on display outside in the "Urban Garden Walk" area. Murals must be in the original shape and must be coated to protect as they are displayed outside.
- 7. All murals will become property of the Erie County Fair.
- 8. Individuals &/or teams will be allowed to compete. A team captain must be designated to be the point of contact. If a team places, one check will be presented in the name of the team captain.
- 9. All murals must be family friendly, any murals containing explicative material (nudity, violence, offensive words, etc.) will lead to disqualification.
- 10. The mural's theme is to be centric around The Erie County Fair and "Sights, Sounds, Tastes, and Feels of the Fair".
- 11. Art that represents another fair besides the Erie County Fair will be disqualified and not judged.
