Join Us for Market Day at the Jefferson County Fair!

Get ready for Market Day at the Jefferson County Fair on Friday, July 12! This is the perfect opportunity for anyone looking to display and sell crafts, flowers, and market items in a lively and welcoming environment. We invite all artisans, crafters, and market enthusiasts to join us and share their unique products with the fairgoers. The spirit of this event is a craft fair and market day, so please ensure that all products sold and displayed are family friendly. No soliciting people to your booth is allowed, and if you have any questions about the guidelines, feel free to ask before signing up.

Entry: Participants will enter on-line through the link below or stop into the Fair Office to complete an entry form. There is a \$30.00 entry fee per space. Register soon, as there is a July 1 entry deadline.

Display area: All booths will be assigned a 10' X 20' space located in the "Heart of the Fair Park" between the Activity Center and the Dairy Barn. The event will run from 8am to 8pm. There will not be electricity, chairs, or tables available. Tents are encouraged.

Arrival & Departure: Enter through gate 4 between 7am and 8am. All vehicles must be off grounds by 8 am. Parking will be available off-grounds outside gate 4 or with additional trailer parking across the road from gate 1. A soft managed release at 8pm will be conducted through gate 4.

Reminders:

- An event ambassador will be on site to help you upon arrival and will further coordinate the days relevant messages as well as the organized release.
- Daily gate admission is **NOT** included in the entry fee.
- This event will be held rain or shine.
- Limited spaces are available, so register soon.
- Off-site parking is not next to your display area, so consider the use of a wagon or cart to assist should additional items be needed during the day.
- This is the first year of this event, so we appreciate your cooperation and patience as we navigate the particulars. Further, we welcome your feedback for consideration of a future event of this nature.
