

Latah County Fair

4-H/FFA Market Rabbit Project Policy

Exhibitor Eligibility: Exhibitor must be currently enrolled and in good standing in a Latah County 4H market rabbit project or Latah County FFA SAE.

Breed/Type: All 3 rabbits in the pen will be the same ‘meat type’ breed and the same variety, but do not have to come from the same litter.

Exhibit Age: Maximum age is 10 weeks at the time of the Latah County Fair check-in. Animal age will be determined by the Show Superintendent(s). Any projects exceeding the age limit will show in an exhibition-only quality class and receive a green ribbon.

Sale Minimum/Maximum Weight & Age: The Minimum / Maximum weight will be set by the Latah Market Animal Sale Committee, any projects not meeting or exceeding the weight limits will show in an exhibition-only quality class and receive a green ribbon, sale eligibility is determined by the LMAS Committee. LMAS Committee may also set age restrictions, that will be published in the annual Fair Book.

Permanent Identification: All market pen rabbits will be tattooed by the Show Superintendent at fair check-in. Market animals will receive a tattoo in their right ear.

Health: All rabbits will receive a health inspection at the time of check-in. Animals showing symptoms of any contagious disease at check-in or later must leave the shows grounds immediately.
