Special Rules

1. All Cars Must Be Pre-Registered. For information and registration forms, please contact the show chairman.
2. Entries are open to all New Mexico Model “T” Fords regardless of condition.
3. Participants are encouraged to enter original unrestored cars, partially restored cars, as well as completed cars.
4. All cars will meet on South Main Street by 8:00 AM, cars must be set by 9:00 AM! Enter through Gate #3 - **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
5. Cars must stay on exhibit from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM, Exit Time will be 3:00 PM through Gate #6 at the direction of State Fair officials.
6. Cars must have entry # and stanchions/rope or other for display. State Fair will provide placards, ribbons and space.
7. In the interest of safety; placement and location of vehicles will be directed by New Mexico State Fair personnel and staff.
8. Vehicles are only to be displayed on the street. Vehicles are **NOT** allowed to be displayed on grass areas.
9. **“For Sale” is not to be displayed on any Tractors in the Show.**
10. Exhibitor recognizes that marketing of the Fair and its grounds requires use of photography and video. Exhibitor hereby expressly grants to the Fair the irrevocable, assignable right and license to take, use and publish exhibitor images and property without the need for any other approval. Exhibitor also releases the Fair, its agents or assigns, from all claims related to the licenses that have been granted in this release.
11. As a participant, volunteer, or attendee, you recognize that your participation, involvement and/or attendance at any Fair event or activity includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to COVID-19.
