#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & GENERAL RULES**

#### **ENTRIES**

Pre-entry closing date is August 15, 2023. Late entries will be accepted with an extra fee of \$15.00/horse, and you may enter at the show.

All exhibitors are encouraged to use the on line entry option at mjmshowservices.com prior to August 15, 2021 to allow time to process your paperwork.

**DO NOT SEND ANY ENTRIES BY MAIL ENTRIES AFTER AUGUST 15, 2023**. Entries sent after August 15<sup>th</sup> must be emailed or completed on line or in person at the show.

Please select all classes ahead of time and indicate these classes on your entry form. Please send check or credit card information with your entry. The NMSF does accept credit cards for payment of horse show fees. All exhibitors must leave an open check or credit card number with the horse show office at the time of check in. An open check or credit card is required to pick up your exhibitor number. You must use a separate form of payment for each show/breed in which you are participating in.

#### In addition to a completed entry form we require the following documents:

- 1. All youth exhibitors showing in Youth and/or Open classes (including Walk/Trot & Lead Line) must include the Minor's Release Form signed by a parent or guardian
- 2. The NMSF Liability Statement on the entry form must be signed
- 3. A completed W9 form including name and SS # must be on file in the horse show office in order to receive payouts and prize money. The person receiving the prize money must be the person listed on the W9 Form

Incomplete Entry – if an entry is received incomplete, it will not be processed and back numbers will not be assigned until all paperwork is completed. If an incomplete entry is received prior to the entry deadline, show management will make an effort to contact the exhibitor to obtain the lacking information. All exhibitors are required to provide a completed W9 at the time of entry.

Entry Fees are listed on each individual class list

There are no additional fees for adding/scratching classes during the show.

#### **STALLS**

Stall/Tack Room fees are \$25.00/night. Each exhibitor is required to pay a 1 stall/1 night fee (\$25.00) Stalls reserved after the reservation deadline will be \$30.00/night

To reserve stalls and tack rooms please complete and submit the stall reservation form Stall/Tack Room \$25.00/night (after reservation deadline - \$30.00)

The NMSF requires that every horse have a stall while exhibiting at the NMSF Horseshow.

Stall Assignments – Stall assignments will be given to exhibitors upon arrival at the horse show office. NMSF Staff will help exhibitors to their assigned stalls if needed. We will do our best to accommodate exhibitor stall requests when possible.

No parking in front of stalls at any time – please keep in mind the NMSF has strict fire codes and guidelines which must be followed at all times.

**FEED & BEDDING** - Feed and bedding is available on the fairgrounds from **Johnny Garcia at 4-W Feed Store (505) 934-2681.** The use of outside shavings is not permitted on fairgrounds. If a medical condition requires the use of special bedding, please provide proper documentation from a licensed veterinarian.

**ADMISSION TICKETS** – In order to make participation in the NMSF Horse Shows easier, you do not need to pre-order admission tickets with your entry forms. Everyone entering the fairgrounds, which includes all horse facilities, must purchase a daily admission ticket. NMSF Admission tickets may be purchased with cash, check or credit card at the Horse Show Office upon arrival. Two admission tickets are provided for each horse entered. An 11 day Season Exhibitor Pass may also be purchased at the Horse Show Office.

**ARRIVAL**– All Horse Show Exhibitors should use Gate 6 "HORSES ONLY" entrance on San Pedro Dr., NE. across from the McDonald's parking lot. Upon entering at the HORSES ONLY entrance, head northeast to the Horse Show Office. The Horse Show Office will assist you with check in and your stall assignments. Staff will assist you with stall locations as needed. The Horse Show Office is open from 8:00 AM – to 1 hour after the conclusion of the show each day. If you will be arriving prior to, or after hours please make arrangements with staff by calling 480-605-6283.

#### **NEW MEXICO BOARD REQUIREMENTS-**

In state livestock must have a current Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) issued within 30 days of arrival for all horses, mules, donkeys. Proof of ownership must accompany the animal when entering fairgrounds except if your horse resides in District 8; either an NMLB "Form 1" (certificate of inspection) or a 1-H (A) permanent inspection card if out of district.

**Out of State Livestock** must have a current Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) issued within 30 days of arrival and is required for all horses, mules and donkeys, and a Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins) Certificate issued within 12 months of arrival on fairgrounds.

Additional requirements for such movement of equines within the state may exist due to special circumstances such as a disease outbreak. #### PARKING- VERY IMPORTANT!

There is a limited amount of parking available at Gate 6. Gate 6T parking permits are given to Horse Show Exhibitors when they check in at the Horse Show Office. To have access to the stall area and to be able to park in the Gate 6 Area (Parking spaces are not guaranteed), Horseshow primary vehicles must have a Gate 6T Parking Permit hanging from the rear view mirror.

There will be no parking in the barn areas except for loading and unloading.

Horse trailer parking is NOT allowed on the fairgrounds or on any of the roads or streets surrounding the fairgrounds. Gate 6T Parking Permits allow exhibitors to park their horse trailers for FREE at the National Guard Armory @ 600 Wyoming Blvd.

NE, Albuquerque, NM 87123. The horse trailer sticker that accompanies the Gate 6T Parking Permit must be affixed to the horse trailer before entering the NGA parking area. The NGA is a secure facility. Horse trailers will not be allowed to enter or to leave the property without the Gate 6T Parking Permit with a sticker matching the sticker on the horse trailer. The NMSF Trailer Parking entrance to the NGA is south of the National Guard Building on Copper Ave. A map to this location will be available at the Horse Show Office upon check in.

Support Vehicles – will be allowed in Gate 6 with access to the stall area for loading and unloading. Support vehicles must check in at the Horse Show Office before entering the stall area. Support vehicles have a 45 minute time limit for loading and unloading. Support vehicles are not allowed to park in the Gate 6 area. After unloading, the support vehicle may be asked to exit the Gate 6 area and park in one of the other designated NMSF parking areas. Paid parking at Gate 8 is also available.

**CAMPING**— There are no camping facilities on the grounds during fair time. The nearest KOA campground is approximately 4.9 miles from the grounds. It is located at 12400 Skyline Rd. NE, Albuquerque, NM 87123. It is near Central Ave. SE which borders the fairgrounds on the south side. Early reservations are strongly recommended. http://koa.com/campgrounds/albuquerque/general-information

**DEPARTURE**– All exhibitors must check out with the Horse Show Office during office hours. The office is open one hour before the show starts and will stay open for 1 Hour of the completion of the daily show. Exhibitors will receive a Horse Release Form from the show office once their account has been settled. The Horse Release Form must be presented at the gate before they will be allowed to leave the fairgrounds with their horses. Horses must vacate fairgrounds by 10:00 PM daily after the conclusion of their show.

#### HORSE SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

The indoor arena, outdoor arenas, stall areas and parking areas are under the control of the Expo New Mexico General Manager or his designee – the Horse Show Manager.

Every horse must be in a halter or bridle and under control of the handler at all times while on the fairgrounds. If the Horse Show Manager believes an unruly horse to be a danger to itself or others, he may excuse the horse from the competition grounds.

The Horse Show Manager has the right to expel any participant and their horse(s) from the Fairgrounds without liability at any time during the NMSF. Reasons for expulsion include but are not limited to intoxication, threatening or disruptive behavior, unsportsmanlike conduct, abusive treatment of any animal, unruly horses, etc.

Horseshow Management may reject any entry for any reason without liability prior to and/or during the NMSF Show.

Only Exhibitors and Horse Show Staff deemed necessary by Horse Show Management may be in an arena while classes are taking place in that arena.

**ARENA** – The indoor arena is 117' x 250'; Outdoor arena is 125' x 264'. Footing in all arenas and warm up areas is sandy loam.

**CHANGES TO PREMIUM BOOK** – The Horse Show Manager reserves the right to adjust the Horse Show Schedule of Classes or to substitute Judges without notice if necessary. The NMSF will not be liable for any misprint of rules, classes or schedules. NMSF reserves the right to adjust the schedule or to substitute judges without notice if necessary. Any changes or

corrections will be posted at NMSF's website at <a href="https://www.exponm.com">www.exponm.com</a> and on the website of MJM Show Services at mjmshowservices.com.

**DISPUTE/PROTEST** – Exhibitors wishing to file a protest must do so in writing within 24 hours of the completion of that breed/discipline show day. There will be a Protest Fee of \$100 due at the time the protest is submitted. Show Management will review all documentation provided and determine validity in its discretion. A written response will then be provided. All show management decisions are final.

**DOGS** – Please keep all dog(s) on a leash at all times. Except for Service Dogs, dogs are not allowed south of the Indoor Horse Arena.

**GOLF CARTS AND MOTORIZED VEHICLES** – To operate any motorized vehicle on the New Mexico State Fairgrounds, you must have a valid drivers license or operator's license as defined by the state in which you reside. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from the rule. Golf carts must be registered with NMSF to be driven anywhere on the fairgrounds. Registration Permits can be purchased for \$500.00.

#### LIABILITY-

- 1. NMSF liability statement on entry form must be signed by an adult
- All participants shall defend, hold harmless and indemnify the NMSF and the State of New Mexico and its
  employees from any and all claims, damages, expenses, cost, fees, (including attorney fees) and liabilities of any
  type or description whatsoever arising from the performance of the exhibitor and/or his employees/member
  under this agreement.

**PADDOCK AND GATE** – In order to maintain a smooth and efficient show, the Paddock Master will be responsible for the timely closing of the arena gate so that the next class may begin. Making it to the gate on time is the exhibitor's responsibility. Gate calls are a courtesy and not always possible. Horse Show Management is not required to make a gate call for missing exhibitors. Should there be an unnecessary or unapproved delay in an exhibitor entering the arena for a class, the Paddock Master or Horse Show Manager may excuse the exhibitor from the class.

**PAYMENTS TO NMSF** – If payment is stopped on any check, the exhibitors(s), trainer(s) and owner(s) will be turned in to the National and State approving organizations and may be banned from future NMSF shows. Any check returned by the bank for non sufficient funds will be charged a \$35.00 NSF fee, payable to NMSF. Further action may be taken including, but not limited to, withholding of prize money and awards.



#### PRIZES - PREMIUMS - PAYBACK SCHEDULES

**Prize Money** -1<sup>st</sup> place through 6<sup>th</sup> place in classes with 3 or more entries being shown except as noted. Prize money checks may not be mailed earlier than October 15, 2023. Youth classes do not have prize money except for Hight Point Awards.

Rosettes - 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> Place in all classes

#### **HIGH POINT AWARDS**

1<sup>st</sup> Place (High Point) Receives \$100.00 = NMSF High Point Buckle
2<sup>nd</sup> Place - \$75.00
3<sup>rd</sup> Place - \$50.00

Prizes will be awarded in the following divisions or age groups. Tabulations will include only points earned in classes listed

Point for NMSF High Point Awards are calculated using a 6 point inverse scale. If there are 6 or more horses shown in a class, 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive 6 points, 6<sup>th</sup> place will receive 1 point (6-5-4-3-2-1) If 4 horses are shown in a class, 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive 4 points, 4<sup>th</sup> place will receive 1 point (4-3-2-1). If 1 horse is shown in a class, 1 point per judge will be awarded. Points from judge(s) will be combined to reach total score. In case of a tie, high point ties will be broken in the following ways:

Tie Breaker – Greater number of events, then most riding events, then most first places. Exhibitors must show in a minimum of 3 classes to be eligible for buckles

#### NMSF SHOW MANAGER'S GLOSSARY

AAOTR/AAOTH/AAOTD - Adult Amateur Owner to Ride/Handle/Drive

AATR/AATH/AATD - Adult Amateur To Ride/Handle/Drive

AHA - Arabian Horse Association

Amateur – an exhibitor who is non-professional and does not accept remuneration for horse training, lessons and is 19 years of age or older.

Amateur – Novice or L1 – an exhibitor who is non-professional and does not accept remuneration for horse training, lessons, and is 19 years of age or older and meets the limited point earning qualifications of the associated breed requirements.

Amateur Select - an exhibitor who is non-professional and does not accept remuneration for horse training, lessons and is 50 years of age or older as of show day.

AOTR/AOTH/AOTD - Amateur Owner to Ride/Handle/Drive

AOTS - Amateur Owner Trained and Shown

APHA - American Paint Horse Association

ATR/ATH/ATD – Amateur to Ride, Handle, Drive

ApHC - Appaloosa Horse Club

Armory AKA National Guard Armory – secure location used for parking horse trailers during the New Mexico State Fair, location is 600 Wyoming Blvd, NE, Albuquerque, NM 87123

AQHA – American Quarter Horse Association

Back Number – a number which is given to an exhibitor by the Horse Show Office for the judges to be able to identify each exhibitor in the class. Should be attached to the exhibitor's back and visible to the judges. Not wearing the correct back number as assigned by the show office will result in a disqualification from the class.

Class Fee – a fee charged per judge to enter a specific class

Exhibitor – persons of any age or level who are competing at NMSF Horse Show

Fairgrounds – Expo New Mexico State Fair property/location

Gate 6 – the gate to be used by horseshow and livestock exhibitors for entry onto the fairgrounds

HA/AA - Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian

Horse Show Office – located at the north end of the indoor horse show arena. Horse Show Office will complete all entries, issue back numbers, issue releases for departure, maintains horse show records and points. Office will open 1 hour prior to daily show and will remain open for 30 minutes at the conclusion of each daily show

Horses Helping – Therapeutic equestrian competition for children and/or adults and veterans facing daily life challenges

JOTR/JOTH/JOTD - Junior Owner/Handler/Driver

JTR/JTH/JTD - Junior to Ride/Handle/Drive

Junior – refers to the age of Mules and Donkeys which are 2 Years of age or younger

Junior Horse – refers to the age of horses which are 5 years of age and younger

L1 (Exhibitor) – an exhibitor who has not earned a certain number of AQHA points in a class. Must meet eligibility and membership requirements and provide documentation <a href="https://www.aqha.com/services/leveling">www.aqha.com/services/leveling</a>

L1 (Horse) – a horse who has not earned a certain number of AQHA points in a class. Must provide documentation <a href="https://www.aqha.com/services/leveling">www.aqha.com/services/leveling</a>

Maiden Horse (Open All Breed) – a horse that has not won a blue ribbon prior to September 5, 2021

National Guard Armory – See Armory

Non Pro (ApHC) an exhibitor who is 19 years of age or older and who does not receive remuneration for training or lessons. Must meet eligibility membership requirements

Non Pro Masters (ApHC) - an exhibitor who is 50 years of age or older and who does not receive remuneration for training or lessons. Must meet eligibility membership requirements

Non Rated – A class or division that is not approved by the represented breed

Novice Youth – A youth exhibitor, 18 years of age or younger who has not met the breed organization's minimum number of points to advance. Must meet membership requirements.

Office Fee – Fee charged for every horse participating at the NMSF Show

Open Check — A check made out to NMSF, signed with the amount left blank. An invoice will be printed at the end of the show for your review and finalization of fees. A separate check or credit card is required for each show/breed. Your show account tab must be closed out at the end of each individual breed/discipline. No carry over of single check or credit cards across shows.

Participant – Any person or company associated with the competition of a horse in the NMSF horse shows. This includes but not limited to: Owner, Trainer, Lessee, Parent/Guardian, groom, etc.

Pay Backs – Prize money offered by NMSF to classes with a minimum of three exhibitors competing in each class. Payback will be paid as indicated in the payback schedules listed.

PHBA - Palomino Horse Breeders of America

Premiums – same as Pay Backs

Primary Vehicle – the vehicle used to transport horses and horse trailer to the NMSF shows

Secondary Vehicle - additional vehicles needed to bring equipment, supplies, passengers

Senior – refers to a Mule/Donkey 3 years of age or older

Senior Horse – refers to a horse 6 years of age or older

Show Day – Any day that the exhibitors and horses are being judged in classes

SPB – Refers to an American Paint Horse that is of paint parentage but does not exhibit the color pattern and required white markings of the regular registry paint horses. A Solid Paint Bred Horse is referred to SPB

Stall Night – Example: if you are arriving the day before you show on 9/8 and leave after you show in 9/9, you will only be charged for a single stall night. The number of overnight stays that a stall is occupied.

Walk/Trot (APHA) - Must meet membership requirements. May enter any walk/trot class, halter and showmanship but may not cross enter into three gaited classes.

Walt/Trot (AQHA) – Must meet L1 membership requirements. May enter any walk/trot class, halter and showmanship but may not cross enter any corresponding lope classes

Youth – An exhibitor who is 18 years of age or younger as of January 1 of the current year and meets the membership requirements of the breed in which they are exhibiting.


