### **RULES GOVERNING ANTIQUE EXHIBITS**

- 1. Entries close 5:00 PM First Friday in August
- 2. Exhibitor must have season pass
- 3. Champion & Best of Show Awards are given per judges' discretion per department, division, or class.
- 4. All exhibits to be in place by 6 pm on Tuesday of fair week. Supt. will receive entries Monday 10 am-6 pm & Tuesday Noon-6 pm.
- 5. To expedite the return of your items please write the entry number and a brief description on each corresponding stub. Alphabetize by division letter for ease of check out.
- 6. Check out is Tuesday after the fair Noon to 6 p.m.
- 7. Exhibitors must bring their own entries to the fair prepared with entry tag prior to arrival.
- 8. No professionals/dealers may exhibit in this department. A professional/dealer is defined as someone "who consistently derives monetary income from teaching or work in the area of antiques or collectibles".
- Each exhibitor will be permitted to submit only one entry in any one class. <u>All exhibits must be odor free of all mold, dust and mildew</u>. Please read each entry description carefully. Items entered under the wrong entry number may be disqualified. Exhibitors are limited to 30 entries.
- 10. Exhibitors must bring their own entries to the fair prepared with entry tag prior to arrival.
- 11. Antiques should be 70 years or more old, unless otherwise specified
- 12. All items are one unless otherwise specified.
- 13. Judges have been carefully selected. All exhibitors submitting exhibits at the fair accept these Judges and agree to abide by their decisions. The decision of the judge will be final in all classes. Any exhibitor who attempts to interfere with the judge in any manner will forfeit all premiums awarded.
- 14. No items previously receiving an award at this Fair will be accepted for competition until a period of three (3) years has passed.

Superintendents in charge and their assistants will take every precaution for the safe keeping of all items on exhibit after their arrival, by the Walworth County Agricultural Society, Inc. their employees and volunteers will not be responsible for loss or damage that may occur.
