## **RULES GOVERNING BEEF EXHIBITS**

- 1. Entries close 5:00 PM First Friday in August
- 2. Exhibitor must have a season pass
- 3. NOTICE Livestock to be in place by Thursday during the Fair, 7:00 p.m. 9:00 p.m. Displays must be done by Sunday before Fair. Enter fairgrounds via the North Gate.
- 4. Health and Registration Papers must be shown to the Superintendent.
- 5. No bedding furnished by the fairgrounds
- 6. No Livestock will be allowed to leave until 4pm. Monday, Labor Day
- 7. Space allotment will be determined by the number of animals brought to the fair and not by the number of animals entered. Any animal number or class that is to be scratched needs to be communicated to the superintendent one week previous to animal unloading day of the fair.
- 8. Beef space allotment will be guided by the following: each heifer gets one stall hole, each cow and/or bull gets one and a half holes, and each exhibitor gets two holes for every five animals brought for feed and tack space. When total ends with a half hole it will be rounded up. Odd spacing areas will be designated for chutes and fitting areas.
- 9. No display set-up can be more than 6 feet wide and no display item can protrude into the walkway aisle. Large furniture (i.e., Couches, recliners, etc.) will **NOT** be allowed.
