RABBIT & CAVIE RULES

- 1. All entries in all divisions of this Department close on MONDAY, JULY 14, 2025. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE DONE ONLINE BY MONDAY, JULY 14 AT 11:59 PM AND PAID, total amount of entry fees, and \$23.00 to cover the Exhibitor's wristband OR a membership to the Erie County Agricultural Society Membership. Exhibitor wristband will only be valid for the time the animals are at the fair. * NO WRISTBANDS WILL BE GIVEN UNTIL ENTRIES ARRIVE AT THE FAIR* Parking pass not included please utilize the free parking throughout the Erie County Fair parking lots.
- 2. All exhibits <u>must remain</u> until 8:00 PM, Tuesday, August 12th, 2025. Exhibitors whose exhibits are removed before the stated time will automatically forfeit their premium money or not be allowed to exhibit the following year. All exhibits must be called for by 10:00 PM Tuesday, August 12th, 2025. No cooping out hours on Monday. Any exhibits left after said time, are at owner's risk.
- 3. All New York State Veterinarian decisions are final and supported by Erie County Fair Staff inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated and can result in forfeit of premiums and removal from fair.
- 4. All entries must be owned and brought to the Fair by the exhibitor. No exceptions!!!
- 5. The Society will not be responsible for loss, damage, mistakes or accidents. Feed and water will be supplied free of charge. Rabbits are fed once a day in the evening. The owner is responsible for the care of their own animals if they wish them to have special provisions.
- 6. A health check will be conducted on day of arrival to fair.
- 7. Rules of the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets Standards for the Conduct of Agriculture and Markets for Fairs and Summary of Livestock Health Requirements shall apply.
- 8. Youth exhibitors may enter any animal in the Open Class department. However, when entering in open class the youth must pay ALL appropriate fees; this includes the exhibitor wristband, entry fees.
- 9. Competition is open to exhibitors from the United States and Canada.
- 10. In the event that more entries are received than space available, exhibitors may be asked to reduce their number of entries.
- 11. Exhibitors will be allowed to present exhibits to the Judge unless they cannot be present. If exhibitor cannot be present the day of the show, they are asked to inform the superintendent, and a presenter will be assigned by the superintendent.
- 12. Senior rabbits are all specimens over six months of age in Four Class Breeds, over eight months of age in Six Class Breeds. An intermediate rabbit is a specimen in six Class Breeds only that is between the ages of six and eight months. Junior rabbits are all specimens under six months of age.
- 13. No changes of Rabbits, Sex, Variety or Tattoos after Rabbits are checked in. Wrong sex and wrong ear numbers will be disqualified.
- 14. No pregnant rabbits or cavies should be entered into the Erie County Fair.
- 15. No tattooing of rabbits or cavies at the fair. This must be done prior to arrival or exhibits will not be allowed to enter.
- 16. Rabbit/Cavy exhibitors can bring "sale animals" to sell while at the fair but MUST follow the below criteria otherwise will not be permitted to sell animals.
 - a. Exhibitor MUST have at least 5 show animals exhibited in the Erie County Fair Rabbit/Cavy Show.
 - b. Exhibitor MUST work a minimum of 5 hours in the poultry and rabbit barn during the open poultry and rabbit stay of the Erie County Fair.
 - c. Sale animals CAN NOT be entered in the Erie County Fair Rabbit/Cavy Show. Animals entered in the show are NOT allowed to be sold.
 - d. All animals will be health checked on arrival day (August 5th)
 - e. Sale animals will only be allowed to leave the barn between the hours of 9pm-10pm each night.
 - f. Sale animals will have a designated area in the barn. They are not to be cooped/penned with the show animals.
 - g. All sale animals must meet the same health regulations as show animals.
- 17. Open Class and 4-H will be combined on the same stay.

Erie County Fair Dates: August 6-17, 2025

Protest:

- a. Protests regarding any livestock competitions and events held by the Erie County Agricultural Society, during the Erie County Fair, in Hamburg, NY (Youth Livestock Expo & Open Class Livestock Shows) must be made in writing on the appropriate form (link here), plainly stating the reason for the complaint or appeal. This form along with a \$300 cash deposit must be submitted to the CEO of the Erie County Agricultural Society The deposit shall be refunded <u>only</u> if the protest is sustained by the Erie County Agricultural Society CEO. If the protest is not sustained, the \$300 will be donated to the Erie County Agricultural Society scholarship fund.
- b. Classification and Judges opinion are not eligible for protest.
- c. Protests against the exhibition of animals shall be filed at least 3 hours before the start of the show that the animal/ exhibitor is being made against will show in.
- d. The CEO of the Erie County Agricultural Society may hold a meeting regarding the protest at which time the party making the protest may present evidence or argument in support of the protest.
- e. The written decision of the CEO of the Erie County Agricultural Society shall be final and shall be served by certified mail to the party making the protest within five days of the date on which the protest was heard.
- f. Exhibitors of animals at livestock competitions shall at all times deport themselves with honesty and good sportsmanship. Their conduct in this competitive environment shall always reflect the highest standards of honor and dignity to promote the advancement of agricultural education. This code applies to junior as well as open class exhibitors who compete in structured classes of competition. This code applies to all livestock offered in any event at a livestock show.
