RABBIT & CAVIE RULES

- All entries in all divisions of this Department close on **FRIDAY, JULY 16, 2021**. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE DONE ONLINE BY FRIDAY JULY 16 AT 11:59 PM AND PAID**, total amount of entry fees, and \$23.00 to cover the Exhibitor's wristband OR \$75.00 for Erie County Agricultural Society Membership. Exhibitor wristband will only be valid for the time the animals are at the fair. * NO WRISTBANDS WILL BE GIVEN UNTIL ENTRIES ARRIVE AT THE FAIR*
- All exhibits **must remain** until 8:00 PM, Sunday August 22, 2021. Exhibitors whose exhibits are removed before the stated time will automatically forfeit their premium money or not be allowed to exhibit the following year.
- All entries must be owned and brought to the Fair by the exhibitor. No exceptions!!!
- All exhibits must be called for by 10:00 PM Sunday, August 22, 2021. No cooping out hours on Monday. Any exhibits left after said time, are at owner's risk.
- The Society will not be responsible for loss, damage, mistake or accident. Feed and water will be supplied free of charge. Rabbits are fed once a day in the evening. The owner is responsible for the care of their own animals if they wish them to have special provisions.
- A health check will be conducted on day of arrival to fair.
- Rules of the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets Standards for the Conduct of Agriculture and Markets for Fairs and Summary of Livestock Health Requirements shall apply.
- Youth exhibitors may enter any animal in the Open Class department. However, when entering in the open class the youth must pay ALL appropriate fees; this includes the exhibitor wristband, entry fees.
- Competition is open to exhibitors from the United States and Canada.
- In the event that more entries are received than space available, exhibitors **may** be asked to reduce their number of entries.
- Exhibitors will be allowed to present exhibits to the Judge unless they cannot be present. If exhibitor cannot be present the day of the show, they are asked to inform the superintendent, and a presenter will be assigned by the superintendent.
- Senior rabbits are all specimens over six months of age in Four Class Breeds, over eight months of age in Six Class Breeds. An intermediate rabbit is a specimen in six Class Breeds only that is between the ages of six and eight months. Junior rabbits are all specimens under six months of age.
- No changes of Rabbits, Sex, Variety or Tattoos after Rabbits are checked in. Wrong sex and wrong ear numbers will be disqualified.
- No pregnant rabbits or cavies should be entered into the Erie County Fair.
- No tattooing of rabbits or cavies at the fair. This must be done prior to arrival or exhibits will not be allowed to enter.
- Rabbit/Cavy exhibitors can bring "sale animals" to sell while at the fair but **MUST** follow the below criteria otherwise will not be permitted to sell animals.
 - Exhibitor **MUST** have at least 5 show animals exhibited in the Erie County Fair Rabbit/Cavy Show.
 - Exhibitor **MUST** work a minimum of 5 hours in the poultry and rabbit barn during the open poultry and rabbit stay of the Erie County Fair.
 - Sale animals **CAN NOT** be entered in the Erie County Fair Rabbit/Cavy Show. Animals entered in the show are **NOT** allowed to be sold.
 - All animals will be health checked on arrival day (August 16th)
 - Sale animals will only be allowed to leave the barn between the hours of 9pm-10pm each night.
 - Sale animals will have a designated area in the barn. They are not to be cooped/penned with the show animals.
 - All sale animals must meet the same health regulations as show animals.
