Entry Charge: \$8 per head (no additional charges for group classes)

- 1. There will be a limit of 20 animals from one exhibitor. exhibitor is defined as the same farm or family.
- 2. After using the wash rack, area must be cleaned. Animals cannot be tied and left at the racks. Be courteous of other exhibitors' need to use the wash rack, too.
- 3. Any hose or other connection to the water at the wash rack must have a shut-off nozzle.
- 4. All animals must be registered with their respective National Breed Association or be eligible for registration upon reaching the proper age prescribed by that Association. Premiums will not be paid if registration papers have not been checked. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to check in registration papers with the supervisor or the Livestock Office.
- A minimum of 20 head of cattle (provided by 2 or more exhibitors not from the same farm or family) will be required to constitute competition in any one breed. Failure to meet this requirement for 2 consecutive years will result in the elimination of that separate breed class.
- 6. ALL OTHER RECOGNIZED BREEDS If there is no competition in any one breed, livestock may be grouped together in an "All Other Recognized Breeds" class.
- 7. Grand & Reserve Champion Female of each breed will receive a Special Award.
- 8. The use of straw is prohibited at the Fairpark. Wood shavings will be provided for initial bedding.

The following practices or procedures are considered unacceptable and defined as being fraudulent and/or unethical:

- Treating the animal, particularly the udder, internally or externally:
 - with an irritant or counter irritant
 - o using a device to artificially create or enhance the udder crease.
 - o using other substances as detected by testing that cause changes in the udder to artificially improve the conformation.
 - o Improper fitting practices such as overfilling or over-bagging

12. The maximum allowable length of naturally growing hair anywhere on the topline is not to exceed 1 1/2 inches. Exhibitors will be required to comply with this rule before the animal is allowed to enter the ring.

- 27. Breeders Herd of Five Females this group, all owned by one exhibitor, consists of two females over two years of age, two females under two years of age and one any age. Three must be bred by the exhibitor. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry.
- 28. Produce of Dam Two animals, any age, either sex, the produce of one cow. Dam must be named. Animals need not be owned by one exhibitor.
- 29. Progeny Group Dam and one (1) progeny.
