DIVISION RULES

- 1. All cattle must be purebred and have original ASA registration papers to show in the purebred division or have green Shorthorn Plus papers for the Shorthorn Plus Show. Shorthorn Plus animals must be 50% Shorthorn blood concentration or higher.
- 2. Shorthorn Plus and Durham Red animals are only eligible to show at designated Shorthorn Plus shows. Regional show points will be awarded only if all shows within the regional have a Shorthorn Plus show. All Shorthorn Plus animals must be 50% Shorthorn blood concentration or higher (7/16 if dam or sire is purebred 15/16) to be eligible for regional or national Shorthorn Plus shows.
- 3. All classes are subject to be split into smaller classes, if deemed necessary.
- 4. The Color Rule of no black hair or no black hide on purebreds will be strictly enforced.
- 5. No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.
- 6. All animals must be registered as the property of the exhibitor in the records of the ASA by the time of the fair or show.
- 7. Family bred and raised animals entered by juniors in Junior Classes and subsequently entered in Open Classes may be treated as family entries in group classes. Group classes need to be pre-entered.
- 8. All Shorthorns and Polled Shorthorns are subject to a tattoo inspection by representatives of the American Shorthorn Association or Oklahoma Shorthorn Association. All Shorthorn and Polled Shorthorn are also subject to an age inspection if deemed necessary by the ASA and the decision of the examining veterinarian is final. Use of artificial fins on show animals is not permitted.
- 9. Senior/Junior Yearling Pregnancy Rule for exhibitors at all Open shows: Any senior/junior yearling female 28 months of age or older on or before the date of the show must have a registered natural calf at side and must be shown with such. All females 20 months of age on the day of the show need to have a pregnancy verification signed by an accredited, non-owner veterinarian at the time the female is processed for the show. If verification cannot be produced upon request, the exhibitor is allowed to find a qualified veterinarian to verify pregnancy prior to time of show. Any infractions against this rule will lead to disqualification of that animal for that specific show.
- 10. Cow/Calf must show with natural calf at side and calf cannot be over 280 days of age on show day.
- 11. Premiums: 1st \$50, 2nd \$40, 3rd \$30, 4th \$20
