- 4. All bulls are required to be shown with a nose lead (permanent nose ring if 12 months of age or older).
- 5. Exhibitors must wear western attire, long sleeve shirt or long sleeve blouse with collar and cuffs and pants or skirt with boots, while exhibiting cattle in the show ring.
- 6. The Tulsa State Fair will furnish \$5,700 of the premium money and the Oklahoma Texas Longhorn Association will furnish \$1,500 of the premium money.

Showmanship Classifications

Pee Wee: EXHIBITION CLASS: Youth six years and younger may show calves, male or female. This is the only class that will allow adults in the show ring.

Division I: Junior Showmanship. Exhibitors 7-9 years of age as of January 1, 2026.

Division II: Intermediate Showmanship. Exhibitors 10-12 years of age as of January 1, 2026.

Division III: Teen Showmanship. Exhibitors 13-15 years of age as of January 1, 2026.

Division IV: Senior Showmanship: Exhibitors 16-18 years of age as of January 1, 2026. The top age limit for the Senior Division will be 18 years or the year of graduation from high school. (Seniors may not show following the National Show the year of their graduation.)

In Showmanship Classes youth must exhibit an animal that was shown in competition in the TLBT Show.
