DIVISION RULES

- Sanctioning:** This is an officially sanctioned ADGA Show - ADGA rules and Tulsa State Fair rules will govern. The Junior and Senior shows are separately sanctioned. The order of the show is subject to change.
- Breeds Offered:** Alpine, , La Mancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhaslis, Recorded Grades, Toggenburg, All Other Purebreds (AOP).
- Registration Papers:** All dairy goats exhibited must be registered with the American Dairy Goat Association and shown in accordance with current ADGA show rules for registration. The animal must be owned by the exhibitor.
- Age:** The base date for computing the age of the animal shall be the day the animal is to be judged.
- Group Classes:** All group classes of a breed must be made up of only those animals that have been shown in the individual classes of that breed in this show and must be entered on the official entry blank.
- Milkout:** There will be NO pre-show milkout.
- Pens:** Pens will be assigned. Back drops and side curtains will be permitted on tack pens. However, these must be no higher than regular pen height. Farm and club displays may be set up in Dairy Goat pen areas.
- Tattoos:** All dairy goats entered in this Dairy Goat show must have a tattoo. Any goat said to be without a tattoo by the judge of the show will forfeit the premium money given by the Tulsa State Fair.
- Premiums:** 1st - \$40, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20, 4th - \$10

SPECIALS

Best Udder: Judge will pick one doe from each Senior Doe Class to compete for this award. Does must be milked out for this class. To be eligible to win an award, doe must have been shown in Open Senior Doe classes and must have been chosen by the judge to compete.

Premier Exhibitor: Exhibitor winning the most money on 8 animals owned and exhibited by him in the open single classes; award automatically figured on top 8 animals winning the most money.

Premier Breeder: Breeder of, not to exceed, 8 animals winning the most money in open single classes, including animals bred by him but exhibited by others; award automatically figured on top 8 animals winning the most money.

Champion Challenge: The following rules must apply:

A. Permanent champions may show in either the regular or Challenge class, whichever the owner chooses.

B. Grand Champion of the same show must show in this class and winner of them shall be called "Best of Breed".

C. If the Grand Champion of the day does not win this class, she shall not compete in the Best Doe in Show Class.

The winner of the Challenge class shall.

GROUPS (Limit to one entry per exhibitor per group. Only enter once for each group. For example, do not enter all three best three juniors, only one.)

Junior Get of Sire: To consist of 3 junior does, the get of one sire. Sire must be named.

Junior Produce of Dam: To consist of 2 junior does, the daughters of 1 dam. Dam must be named.

Junior Best 3 Females: To consist of 3 does, all owned by exhibitor.

Senior Dam and Daughter: To consist of dam and her daughter. Each entry must consist of one dam and one daughter (no trios) dam or daughter may be entered only once. Both animals must be senior does.

Senior Get of Sire: To consist of three does from the Senior Division, the get of one sire. Sire must be named.

Senior Produce of Dam: To consist of two does from the Senior Division, the daughters of one dam must be named.

Senior Best Three Females: To consist of three Senior Does, all must be owned by exhibitor.

Dairy Herd: To consist of four does in milk, all must be owned by one exhibitor.

DIVISION RULES

- Eligibility:** This show is open to all youth 18 and younger.
- Entries: Separate entries will need to be made to enter into the youth show.** Youth exhibitors may show animals in both Youth and Open classes, provided they pay the required processing fees for each show. Does in the youth show must be registered in the youth exhibitor's name only.
- Registration Papers:** All dairy goats exhibited must be registered with the American Dairy Goat Association and show in accordance with current ADGA show rules for registration.
- Age:** The base date for computing the age of the animal shall be the day the animal is to be judged.
- Milkout:** There will be NO pre-show milkout.
- Pens:** Pens will be assigned. No tents or tent like structures will be permitted in the Dairy Goat pen area. Back drops and side curtains will be permitted on tack pens. However, these must be no higher than regular pen height. Farm and club displays may be set up in Dairy Goat pen areas.
- Tattoos:** All dairy goats entered in this Dairy Goat show must have a tattoo. Any goat said to be without a tattoo by the judge of the show will forfeit the premium money given by the Tulsa State Fair.
- Premiums:** 1st - \$40, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20, 4th - \$10

DIVISION RULES

The Tulsa State Fair ring and the Green Country ring will run simultaneously during the junior and senior show of the Tulsa State Fair. Additional handlers may be available, but we encourage exhibitors to plan accordingly.

1. **Sanctioning:** This is an officially sanctioned ADGA Show – ADGA rules and the Tulsa State Fair rules will govern. The Junior Show and Junior/Senior Combined shows are separately sanctioned. The order of the show is subject to change to keep the show progressing in a timely manner.
2. **Registration Papers:** All dairy goats exhibited must be registered with the American Dairy Goat Association and show in accordance with current ADGA show rules for registration.
3. **Age:** The base date for computing the age of the animal shall be the day the animal is to be judged.
4. **Dress:** Exhibitors are asked to dress appropriately in white as outlined in the ADGA Guidebook.
5. **Milkout:** There will be NO pre-show milkout.
6. **Pens:** Pens will be assigned.
7. **Tattoos:** All dairy goats entered in this Dairy Goat show must have a tattoo. Any goat said to be without a tattoo by the judge of the show will forfeit any awards per ADGA rules.

SPECIALS Challenge: The following rules must apply:

- a. Permanent champions may show in either the regular or Challenge class, whichever the owner chooses.
- b. Grand Champion of the same show must show in this class and winner of them shall be called "Best of Breed".
- c. If the Grand Champion of the day does not win this class, she shall not compete in the Best Doe in Show Class. The winner of the Challenge class shall.
