RULES

- 1. Entries made in this department shall be subject to the General Rules, Livestock Rules, and Division Rules. If there is a conflict between the Division Rules and the General Rules or Livestock Rules and Regulations, the Division Rules will govern. Any case not provided for in the foregoing Division Rules will be referred to the JR. HEIFER & BULL SHOW Committee and Livestock Director's in Charge for a decision.
- 2. All entries are subject to follow the rules outlined by Cattleac as the sanctioning show.
- 3. Entries in the JR. HEIFER & BULL SHOW must be registered and recorded in the recognized book of records for their respective breed. Certificates of Registration must be presented at the time of check-in and registered in the exhibitor's name only. No copies. Scramble heifer exhibitors must have a copy of registration papers and prove the heifer is a scramble heifer. ARB & ORB exhibitors must present the Show Officials with their Certificate of Registry.
- 4. Entries must be made through the Showmanapp and will be accepted the day of show.
- 5. Showmanship will be \$10 and must be done prior to the show. Showmanship will be split as follows:
 - a. Senior 15-18 years of age
 - b. Intermediate 12-14 years of age
 - c. Junior 9-11 years of age
 - d. Peewee -8 and under
 - i. Age as of January 1st, 2024
- 6. There will be a \$20.00 cash deposit assessed per head of cattle. Stalls must be cleaned thoroughly prior to leaving or you will not receive your deposit back and must be approved by show officials.
- 7. Check-in will be from **7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 21, 2024**. All exhibitors must unload, park in the designated area, and then check in. No showing off trailers. Cattle must be stalled in barn.
- 8. The Fort Bend County Fair reserves the right to reject or dismiss any animal from the show that cannot be controlled properly, and is deemed dangerous or undesirable or is showing symptoms of disease or health problems.
- 9. Chutes, fans, and equipment are not allowed in aisles or walkways. Washing or shampooing will be performed in the wash rack only.
- 10. Generators can only be placed on outlying areas of the barns.
- 11. Only sand bedding and shavings will be allowed. Straw or hay bedding is strictly prohibited.
- 12. Electrical equipment and cords will be used with caution and must be used in compliance with all federal, state, and municipal occupational safety and health regulations. Defective equipment or the overloading of circuits will not be allowed.
- 13. Judging will begin at 9:30 a.m. Saturday, September 2, 2024. Order of judging will be Showmanship (Senior, Intermediate, Junior and PeeWee), Heifers (American, British, and Exotic by breed order) starting with show ring A. Bulls will show by division only as follows: American, British, and Exotic. Bulls will show after heifers.

- 14. There will be two shows, show A & show B. One head constitutes a breed. Bulls will **not** be shown by breed, only division and by birthdate.
- 15. Exhibitor must be a member of an FFA chapter or a 4-H club and be between the ages of 8 thru 19 years. Exhibitor must be attending school below the college level and eligible to show.
- 16. Only entries through Showmanapp will be accepted.
- 17. All exhibitors must show their animals at all times while in the ring, including, but not limited to class, breed, division, and grand champion competitions. The only exception shall be if the member has more than one animal in the class or another ring of competition at that same show.
- 18. This will be a "Blow and Go Only Show". No grooming products will be allowed.
- 19. Bulls over 15 months of age must have a nose ring (permanent or temporary) and a nose lead attached to the halter to be eligible to show.
- 20. Bulls up to 36 months of age at the time of the show will be eligible to show.
- 21. Exhibitors must check out on Saturday, September 23, 2023 by 7:00 p.m or 30 minutes after the conclusion of the show.
