

The following items are prohibited on board U.S. Navy, U.S. Coast Guard, and Royal Canadian Navy ship tours:

- Food or drinks, including ice chests and coolers
- Pets (except service dogs for the disabled)
- Glass containers
- Guns, knives, clubs, or weapons of any kind
- Mace, pepper spray, spray cans, or other defensive spray or chemicals
- Firearms
- Fireworks or explosives of any kind
- Flammable liquids
- Illegal drugs and/or paraphernalia, including marijuana
- Electronic cigarettes/vapes
- Camera tripods and cameras with lenses greater than 100 mm
- Backpacks, oversized camera bags, or large purses
- Skateboards/bicycles/hover boards
- Gang-related clothing
- Unmanned aerial systems (UAS)/drones
- Strollers

Special consideration will be given to items that accompany small children, handicapped, and/or elderly visitors. Visitors are encouraged to bring as few items as possible when arriving for their tour and are recommended to wear flat-heeled, closed-toe shoes. Due to safety concerns no open-toe shoes will be permitted.
