- Entries are only allowed online at https://washtxfps.fairwire.com. Entries and payments are due by midnight on August 29, 2024. Late entries are accepted until books close at \$120 per head (Both rings included in this fee)!
- Entry fee is \$100 per head, which allows entry in both rings. You may not enter only one ring. Entries are non-refundable.
- No pre-stalling is allowed. No trim chutes or generators are allowed in the barns.
- Cattle will be stalled on sand. No shavings are allowed.
- Three head or less will show as one class in both steer and heifer divisions.
- No health papers are required.
- Cattle are released at the conclusion of their breed. No cattle can remain on the fairgrounds Saturday night.
- A champion showman will be selected in each division for steers and heifers during the show in Ring B only.
