#### Quilt Rules:

- 1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
- 2. All entries must be registered by Friday, July 11, 2025. Entries that are not registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page at <a href="http://www.ecfair.org">www.ecfair.org</a>.
- 3. The Condition of Work **MUST** be clean and not noticeably worn.
- 4. Pre-quilted fabric will not be accepted.
- 5. Please cover the name labels.
- 6. No Quillons.
- 7. Quilts must be within any of the sizes listed below.
- 8. This is a family friendly Fair, not a juried show.
- 9. Only one (1) entry per class. Unless otherwise permitted by the fair.

#### Judging Criteria:

Each category is allowed to have a maximum number of points

Appearance – 20 pts. Construction - 20 pts. Fabrics – 20 pts. Stitches - 20 pts. Artistry – 10 pts. Binding - 10 pts.

Pieced blocks must have matched corners, and binding should have mitered corners. Stitching should be consistent both for hand stitching as well as machine stitching. Overall appearance along with color choice of fabric is taken into consideration.
