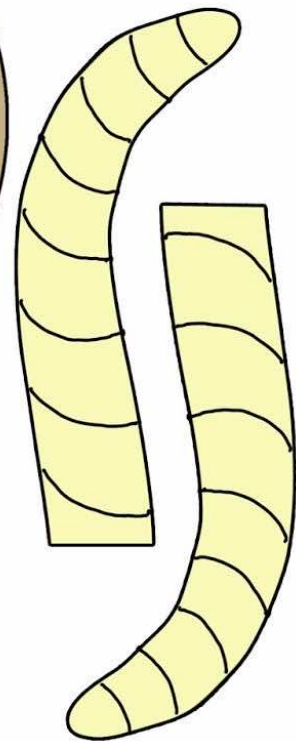
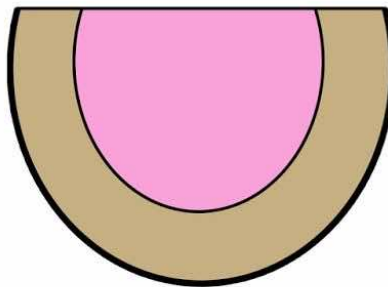
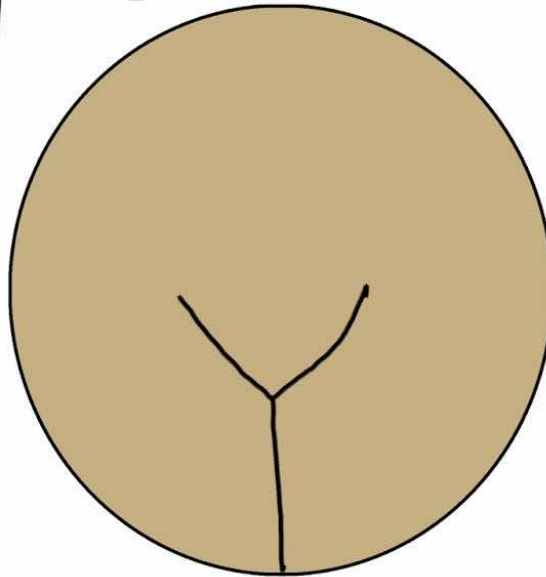
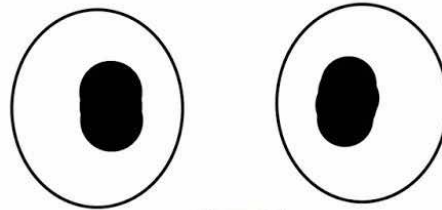
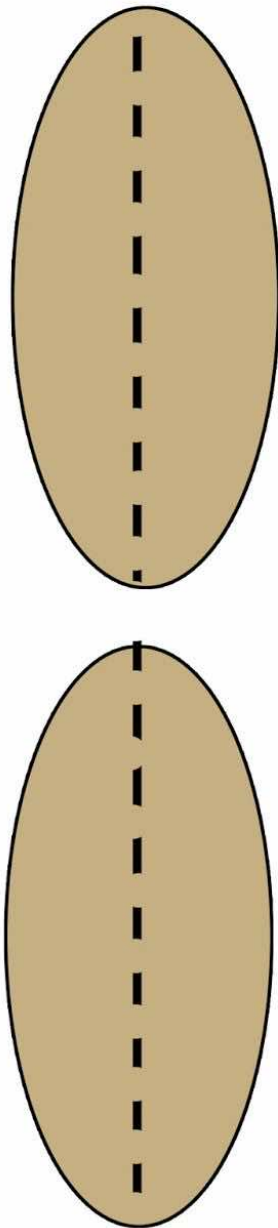
G is for Goat
