- 1. Contestants for the Rodeo Queen must be between the ages of 16 20 at the time of the contest.
- 2. Contestants must be residents of Washington, Douglas, Dodge or Burt county.
- 3. Contestants must be single and never married.
- 4. Contestants shall waive liability.
- 5. Contestants must agree to abide by pageant rules with the possibility of disqualification for infractions.
- Contestantant must fill out the entry application, waiver agreement and release
 of liability forms and supply a photograph of themselves to be used in rodeo
 flyer (3x5 or 4x6 shot preferred).
- 7. Clothing need not be expensive, the judges are looking for personality and familiarity of western wear. Jeans, western shirt, boots and western hat are the basic.
- 8. Suitable western attire will be worn at all times.
- 9. Contestants must be punctual and present at all rodeo activities.
- 10. Disqualification may occur if the contestant or their family attempts to influence the judging process.
- 11. No cell phone use while participating in a pageant event.
- 12. No alcoholic beverages, No tobacco, No profanity will be used during the contest and rodeo events. Good conduct and willingness is expected.
- 13. No Stallions are allowed.
- 14. Split reins are optional, tie downs are allowed.
- 15. The judges decisions are final.
