

# Alabama Jr. & Sr. High School State Cookoff

## Rules

- Students must register for the cookoff prior to the event on [www.bamabeef.org](http://www.bamabeef.org). **Deadline is Monday, March 3, 2025.**
- On the day of the Jr. & Sr. High State Beef Cook-off each contestant should prepare his/her beef dish before arriving to the contest. DISHES CAN **NOT** BE COOKED IN THE BUILDING.
- Turn in time for prepared dishes is 9:45 AM the morning of the cook-off. By arriving early, you will have ample time to make your final preparation to your dish before sending to the judges table.
- The recipe must be cooked and ready to serve when contestants turn in by 9:45 AM.
- A portion of the prepared dish will be heated during judging, if appropriate, prior to being presented to the judges.
- The recipe must list BEEF as the main ingredient.
- The recipe must include **only fresh beef products** that are found at your supermarket.
- Limit sodium and fat in the recipe.
- The recipe used, must be the same recipe prepared for the county contest.
- Student must have competed and won at the county contest coordinated by the Family and Consumer Science/Alabama Cattlemen's Association/Alabama CattleWomen's Association/ Alabama Cooperative Extension county contest coordinators.
- **Student must be enrolled in a home school program or attending a public or private Middle/ High School in the county they won their county Beef Cookoff contest.**
- Student must abide by proper ServSafe food preparation rules while preparing their dish for the beef cookoff. Any product that is not deemed safe or edible by the cookoff chairmen will be automatically disqualified from the contest.

Your dish will be judged on:

Appearance — 10%

Flavor Intensity— 50%

Palatability—20%

Healthfulness & Nutritional Balance—20%
