Please arrange the application attachments in the following order:

- 1) Completed Application Form. Must be signed by applicant and parent/guardian, or digital signature. Must be legible. Attaching a resume is not acceptable.
- 2) Essay topic in 200 words or less: "What are your specific educational plans, career goals and why? What inspires you to achieve them? What makes you stand out differently from your peers?"
- 3) Two Letters of Recommendation.
- 4) High School Transcript.

To be eligible, the student must have completed his/her junior year in high school, be a permanent resident of Florida and reside in one of the following counties: Broward, Hendry, Martin, Okeechobee or Palm Beach.

You may select more than one scholarship category.

SCHOLARSHIP FACT SHEET

The South Florida Fair Scholarship program's purpose is to encourage young people to pursue a higher education and/or trade. These scholarships will be paid as described in each category listed below. The South Florida Fair will award the following scholarships to qualified applicants selected by the Scholarship Committee. The Committee has the right to amend scholarship amounts as it deems necessary. Scholarships must be used within a 5-year period from date of award or will be forfeited back to the South Florida Fair.

\$4,000	1	Paid in increments of \$1,000 per year for a period of four years to the educational institution. For a student in financial need and in good academic standing. Sponsored by the Avellana Family Scholarship
\$1,500	1	For a student exhibiting academic excellence. The Bonlarron Family Scholarship
\$1,500	1	For a student pursuing a degree in nursing. The Elizabeth Gilbert Bowling Family Scholarship
\$2,500	1	For a student exhibiting academic excellence. The Burkhardt Family Scholarship Fund
\$2,500	1	For a student pursuing a degree in Agricultural Studies. The Congressman Mark Foley Scholarship for Agricultural Studies

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SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- 1. The applicant must have completed their junior year in high school, be a permanent resident of Florida, and reside in one of the following counties: Broward, Hendry, Martin, Okeechobee or Palm Beach.
- 2. Additional credit will be given if the applicant is, or has been, a participant in the South Florida Fair's activities. Activities may consist of judging events, exhibits, livestock and agriculture activities, volunteering or any other fair related activity.
- 3. Membership in 4-H or FFA is NOT required.
- 4. The awards will be presented during the annual South Florida Fair in January.
- 5. The scholarship must be used at, and must be paid to, an accredited college, university, or trade school. It will not be paid to the applicant.
- 6. The selection committee requires a personal interview with the applicant. If considered, you will be notified by November 22.
- 7. Advertising and promotional agencies, sponsors, Trustees, Directors, staff of the South Florida Fair and their immediate family members, and/or those living in the same household, are ineligible to apply.
- 8. An essay is required. Those who do not complete the essay will not be eligible for a scholarship. "What are your specific educational plans, career goals and why? What inspires you to achieve them? On your college or trade school applications, what will make you stand out differently from your peers?" (200 words or less).
- 9. Two letters of recommendation are required.
- 10. High School Transcript is required.
