As chairman of the State Fair of Virginia Youth Development Board, I'm proud of how much scholarship money we've been able to award our youth participants through our annual Sale of Champions. Last year's sale raised \$93,725 to support the fair's long-standing commitment to youth. Earlier this year, we distributed over \$36,000

in scholarships to 22 exhibitors who competed at the 2023 State Fair. Since 2013, the fair has awarded more than 2,333 scholarships and has given \$870,273 to support youth education.

I am also proud of the work and communication that has taken place since the 2023 State Fair to address requested changes to the Sale of Champions allocations. These changes will result in a higher percentage of sale funds being awarded to the eight Sale of Champions winners.
