



## 2025 Preliminary Schedule & Information for Queens and Contestants

### **For All Contestants**

#### **February 17<sup>th</sup> Monday**

Contestants' applications are due.

Contestants Meeting at 7:00 p.m. at the ranch house. Review Sponsorships for contestants to sell (provide handouts) Note:

Sponsor banners money is due March 8<sup>th</sup> (need to confirm). All other money must be returned on March 16<sup>th</sup>.

#### **March 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday (optional)**

Interview practice at the Cowboy Church of Ellis County at 6:30 p.m. at the ranch house. This is not mandatory but is recommended. This will give you a chance to answer interview questions.

#### **March 8<sup>th</sup> Saturday (optional)**

Horsemanship practice at 2 p.m. at the Cowboy Church of Ellis County arena. This is not mandatory but is recommended. This will give you and your horse a chance to get used to the arena and the pattern.

#### **March 16<sup>th</sup> Sunday**

Horsemanship, interviews, and impromptu questions start at 2 p.m. (check-in at 1 p.m.) at the Cowboy Church of Ellis County Arena and ranch house. Western dress is required (jeans, hat, boots, etc.). \$250 sponsorships must be sold by each contestant to participate in the contest. Submit money – cash preferred or proof of payment. A negative Coggins is required for all horses. Please make sure you have a copy of your Coggins with you.

#### **March 26<sup>th</sup> Wednesday (Optional)**

Modeling practice at 6 p.m. at the Expo. We will have the opportunity to practice on the actual stage. This is not mandatory but is recommended. Tip: You may want to wear the boots that you plan on wearing during the contest and possibly a dress or skirt.

#### **March 27<sup>th</sup> Thursday**

VIP night from 5-9 p.m. Contestant modeling during fashion show. A script will be provided to the fashion show MC to read about each contestant while they model. Contestants will exit the stage when the MC says thank you. We will announce winners around 6:15 p.m. during prize give aways. Model a western dress. No ticket or donation required for contestants.

Note: A donation will be required at the door for anyone accompanying any contestants (minimum of \$10).

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### March 28<sup>th</sup> Friday

Rodeo performance starts at 7:30 p.m. Queens should arrive at 7 p.m. to help sell programs, photo opportunities at the merchandise booth, introduction by the announcers, meet & greet in VIP section, and other items (more details later). Queens will not need a ticket.

Note: Anyone accompanying the queen will need a ticket. Only committee members will be allowed to escort the queens into the VIP section.

### March 29<sup>th</sup> Saturday

Kids Rodeo from 9:30 am to 1 p.m. to assist with the events and award buckles and medals.

Rodeo performance starts at 7:30 p.m. Queens should arrive at 7 p.m. to help sell programs, photo opportunities at the merchandise booth, introduction by the announcers, meet & greet in VIP section, and other items (more details later). Queens will not need a ticket.

## Sponsorship Information

Each contestant must sell a minimum of \$250 in sponsorships. Points will be awarded for each additional \$250 of sponsorships sold up to a maximum determined by the committee. Each contest is required to bring proof of payment on March 16<sup>th</sup> to receive credit.



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### Queen Sponsorship Levels:
