### Walker County Fair Association Scholarship Rules

- 1. Applicants must be graduating seniors residing in, and/or attending school in Walker County. Applicants must have been accepted for admission to an accredited college, vocational/technical school, or other institution of higher learning. Applicants must be current members of FFA or 4-H in Walker County and have participated as a WCFA exhibitor for at least two of the past four years.
- 2. Applications must be submitted through the WCFA-provided link by the date stated within the application. Only complete applications will be reviewed/scored.
- 3. A complete application does not guarantee a monetary award.
- 4. A Statement of Understanding and Responsibilities must be signed and followed by all graduates who are awarded scholarship funds. This form contains specific disbursement information.
- 5. All scholarship funds will be paid directly to the accredited college, vocational/technical school, or institution of higher learning with proof of enrollment in two installments.

  Fall/Spring semester for traditional programs, and initial/mid-point for non-traditional programs.
- 6. The Walker County Fair Association reserves the right to withdraw scholarship awards, or any unfunded portion of it, under the following circumstances:
  - a. The applicant fails to provide appropriate disbursement documentation by the date disclosed within the Statement of Understanding and Responsibilities.
  - b. The applicant fails to complete a minimum of 12 semester hours, credited on the **fall** semester transcript, which is considered full-time student status.
  - c. The applicant fails to report to the institution for the given semester.
  - d. The applicant fails to maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or higher for the fall semester.
- 7. Any funds not disbursed, by default, will be refunded to the awarding committee's/group scholarship account.

The following committee/group-sponsored scholarships require additional information.

### WCFA Rodeo Committee Scholarship:

Must provide proof of being a member of a sanctioned Rodeo Association for at least two of the past four years; and/or have been an exhibitor in the Walker County Fair for at least two of the past four years.

## WCFA Rabbit Committee Rhonda Fairchild Scholarship:

Applicants for this scholarship must have participated in the WCFA Rabbit program.

#### **Robbie Alexander Scramble Heifer Scholarship:**

Applicants for this scholarship must have participated in the WCFA Scramble Heifer program.

# **WCFA Steer Committee Scholarship:**

Applicants for this scholarship must have participated in the WCFA Steer program.

## WCFA Baked and Canned Goods Scholarship:

Applicants for this scholarship must have participated in the WCFA Baked and Canned Goods program for at least two of the past four years.

## **Brennan Rushing Memorial Scholarship:**

This scholarship is only for students who plan to participate in a trade/vocational program.
