CALIFORNIA RODEO SALINAS SURPASSES OVER \$770,000 TO COMMUNITY NON-PROFITS, WESTERN ORGANIZATIONS, & MORE


On September 13, 2023, the California Rodeo Salinas demonstrated its commitment to the community by contributing **\$771,020** to various local non-profit organizations, Western industry groups, and other community associations. This figure marks a substantial increase of 36% compared to donations made in 2022. Factors contributing to the rise include increased Rodeo attendance, inaugural donations to VetTix, increased scholarship funds, and allocating additional volunteer positions to local organizations. The grand total also encompasses reduced rates for facility rentals and the provision of complimentary tickets to further support the community.






