Early registration is recommended and appreciated.

- Contestants do not have to be farmers. Everyone is welcome!
- Teammates consists of 1 male and 1 female, and do NOT need to be dating, a couple, or related.
- Must be between 16 and 65 years of age. (Under 18 will have to have a parent/guardian sign.)
- Must sign a waiver of liability form.
- Entry fee of \$20 per team must accompany entry form, and once accepted will not be refunded for any reason.
- Limited to first 14 team entries.
- Judges and official's decisions are final.
- Ties: In case of ties in the events, the points will be added and split. The money for tied places will also be added and split in each event. In case of a tie for "Super Farmer", the contestant with the most event wins will win. If a tie still exists, a flip of a coin will decide the winner.
- Point Tabulation | Each event will award points as follows:
 - 1st Place 15 points
 - 2nd Place 12 points
 - 3rd Place 10 points
 - 4th Place 7 points
 - 5th Place 6 points
 - Total Purse \$500
- 6th Place 5 points 7th Place - 4 points
- 8th Place 3 points
- 9th Place 2 points
- 10th Place 1 point
- Each Event Pays: First Place - \$25 Second Place - \$15 Third Place - \$10 Grand Prize - \$100
- The Cass County Super Farmer is dedicated to the Memory of Charles Moreland of Charland Farms in Harrisonville, MO. Mr. Moreland was a life long dairy farmer in Cass County, a devoted family man and an avid farmer.

EVENTS

Bale Stacking: Timed event where each team carries or throws 8 bales of straw from a pile at one end of arena to the other end of arena and restacks them on the ground.

3-Legged Team Penning: Timed event where a team will try to pen three animals in the fastest time using only three legs. CARRYING OF PARTNERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. All animals must circle a barrel before returning to the pen.

Egg Gathering: Timed event where female contestant runs to opposite end of arena, gathers 6 eggs, runs back and proceeds to find the 1 egg that is hard boiled by cracking the eggs on the head of their partner. A 5 second penalty for each broken egg will be added to the total time.

Nail Driving: Timed event where each contestant will drive 3 nails into a board. A 10 second penalty will be added for any nail not driven entirely into the board. Hammers and nails will be provided.

Corn Scoop: Timed event where each contestant will carry a bucket and small hand shovel to opposite end of arena, climb in a pickup and fill their bucket with corn. Filling the bucket any other way is not allowed.

Stick Horse Barrel Race: Timed event to run the standard 3 barrel pattern. Leg of stick horse must stay on ground. The pattern must be completed correctly.

Obstacle Course: Timed event where teammates will back a wagon through an obstacle course with their partner in a wagon. At the other end, teammates will change places and will back the wagon through the course again to the starting line. Team with the fastest time will be the winner.

Partner Carry: Male partner must carry the female partner through a short obstacle course.

Contestants may carry partners however they choose.
