SWINE

- 1. Exhibitors entering open classes in this division should familiarize themselves with the General Rules and Regulations, Livestock Entry Rules and Show Ring Code of Ethics before completing an entry form.
- Exhibitors entering <u>open junior classes</u> should familiarize themselves with Open Junior Show Rules, General Rules, Livestock Entry Rules and Show Ring Code of Ethics before completing an entry form.
- 3. Entry should be made online at <u>www.ozarkempirefair.com</u>. No paper entries will be accepted. Entries close June 15. Late entries will be accepted through July 1 with additional fees.
- 4. Registration and health papers must be in order as they will be checked against the information given on the entry form upon arrival on the Fairgrounds. Animals farrowed after January 1, 2025, may show with litter registration.
- 5. Purebred gilts, boars, and barrows will need to present registration papers to qualify for Purebred classes. Swine without proof of registration papers or are crossbred will show in the crossbred classes.
- 6. Boar entries in the Jr. Breeding show will be shown in two divisions; Purebred by age classes & Crossbred by weight classes. Champion Purebred Boar and Champion Crossbred Boar will compete for the title Grand Champion Boar.
- 7. Ear notches must be legible. No scabby or fresh ear notches allowed.
- 8. Breed Divisions: Division offered if more then 10 head are entered & checked into the 2025 Ozark Empire Fair. If 9 or less entries are received animals will show in All Other Breeds. OEF Management reserves the right to combine, split, or cancel classes in which, in its judgment, the number of entries are insufficient to insure adequate competition, in all departments of the Ozark Empire Fair.
- 9. Chester Whites must hold 10 head in the show for 3 consecutive years to have their own breed. 10 head was not met in 2024.
- 10. The quantity of pens published on the stalling chart are subject to change upon arrival. If you bring less pigs than entered, you are not guaranteed those pens.
- 11. Official identification will be required. A National Uniform Eartagging System tag (NUES) OR an official Animal Identification Number (AIN or 840 tag) will be required. Ear notches need to match the registration paper on each purebred hog.

IUNIOR MARKET SWINE SHOW

Show: Following Junior Breeding Show, Wednesday, July 30

ARRIVAL: Junior Market Swine must be in place by 9 a.m., Tuesday, July 29. No arrival prior to 6 a.m., Tuesday, July 29. **RELEASE:** Junior Market Swine will be released at 6 p.m. Thursday, July 31.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to barrows and gilts that have been farrowed on or after January 1, 2025.
- Swine will be weighed at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, July 30 and must weigh between 220 and 300 pounds. Absolutely NO leniency will be made on weight. 2. Swine WILL BE WEIGHED ONE TIME ONLY. Underweight and overweight swine will show in separate classes before judging of eligible hogs. Underweight and overweight hogs are NOT eligible to show for Champions.
- 3. An exhibitor may enter two animals (can be barrows or gilts).
- Barrows CAN be shown in the Open Barrow show. Gilts must choose between the junior market hog division OR the junior breedinggilt 4. division.
- By completing the online entry form, exhibitor's parent or legal guardian certify that the exhibitor has owned and cared for animals since June 1, 2025 5. or before. Any entries determined ineligible will be returned and no refund will be made.

SHOW

- All barrows and gilts should be entered into Class Y19. 1.
- All barrows and gilts will show together by weight, rather than by breed. Classes will be broken after weigh-in into classes of equal size. 2.
- Under and Over classes Ribbons only (no prize money). 3.

OPEN MARKET BARROWS

Show: Following Open Breeding Gilt Show, Thursday, July 31.

ARRIVAL: All Open Barrows must be in place by 9 a.m., Tuesday, July 29.

RELEASE: 6 p.m. Thursday, July 31.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to barrows that have been farrowed on or after January 1, 2025. 1.
- Swine will be weighed at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, July 29, and must weigh between 220 and 300 pounds. Absolutely NO leniency will be made on weight. 2. Swine WILL BE WEIGHED ONE TIME ONLY. Underweight and overweight swine will show in separate classes before judging of eligible hogs. Underweight and overweight hogs are NOT eligible to show for Champions.
- Must show proof of Purebred barrow registration papers upon check-in or entry will be ran in Crossbred division. 3.
- This is an open show only, junior members who wish to exhibit, may compete in the open division. 4.

SHOW

- All Purebred barrows should be entered into **Open Division. Class 19**. 1
- All Crossbred barrows should be entered into Junior Division, Class 22. 2.
- Barrows will be shown in TWO divisions. Champion Purebred Barrow and Champion Crossbred Barrow will compete for Open Show Grand 3. Champion Market Barrow.
- All Purebred and Crossbred barrows will show by weight, rather than by age. Classes will be broken 4. after weigh-in into classes of equal size.
- 5 Under and Over classes - Ribbons only (no prize money)

IUNIOR SWINE SHOWMANSHIP

Following the show, Wednesday, July 31.

- Classes are open to all youth members eligible to compete in the Ozark Empire Fair Junior Show. 1. Participants must be entered and exhibiting at least one animal in the junior division.
- 2. Only barrows and gilts will be permitted in showmanship drive. No intact males of any species will be allowed to compete in any showmanship event.
- 3. All Junior exhibitors wanting to exhibit in showmanship should be entered in Class 25, 26 or 27.
- Pre-Entry is required by the entry deadline. An Entry fee of \$10.00 will be required. 4.
 - Entry fee's will be "Jackpotted" with 80% of the total fee's paid back to the top three (3) showman in each division, with 45% awarded to first, 35% to second, and 20% to third.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR & PREMIER BREEDER

A Premier Exhibitor award will be presented to the swine exhibitor who accumulates the most points on no more than eight animals during the 2025 Breeding Swine Show. Points can be earned by exhibiting boars and gilts in purebred classes.

A Premier Breeder award will be presented to the swine exhibitor who accumulates the most points on no more than five animals during the 2025 Breeding Swine Show. Points can be earned by exhibiting boars and gilts in purebred classes. The exhibitor must be the breeder and exhibitor of the animals which points are awarded for. This must be entered in advance on the official entry forms.
