The E Stage, located near the Flag Plaza, was developed to showcase emerging artists dedicated to creating original music. Attendees will enjoy a vibrant mix of performers throughout the run of the Fair ensuring there is something for every music lover. The E Stage has always been a hub for discovering new talent, and this year's lineup continues that tradition with a fresh and dynamic roster of artists ready to make their mark.

Sláinte – September 13, 8:30pm

Driven by multi-talented teen siblings, Hello Sister is a Pop Rock band that combines authentic homegrown musicianship with dynamic, high-energy performances and a unique, infectious sound.

JULAI and the Serotones - September 18, 7pm

JULAI and the Serotones are an eight-piece powerhouse band from Connecticut that bring their high-energy sound to listeners worldwide.
