DAY 1 - ARRIVAL DAY

- Stop at Loves Lookout, scenic overlook/visitor center Enjoy one of East Texas' most breathtaking views, north of Jacksonville in Cherokee County.
- Kiepersol Estates Winery & Distillery East Texas' legendary wine and spirits destination offers engaging behind-the-scenes tours. Kiepersol sits atop a peaceful rolling vineyard of grapevines nestled in the forested countryside south of Tyler. The picturesque farm of roaming guinea hens and timeless views produces internationally award-winning wines that are comfortable to drink and can be tasted on site. Personalized tours share stories of twenty years of wine production amidst the backdrop of an 800 barrel two-story cellar. On the other side of the farm, visitors can tour the micro-distillery and batch barrel room producing unique rums, bourbons and vodka.
