Ground Rules

Contestants must be 4-8 years old and weigh no more than 60 pounds.

Helmets and Vests will be provided for each contestant and must be worn.

Release waiver must be signed by parent or legal guardian to participate.

Winner will receive a belt buckle with the second and third place contestants to receive a trophy.

Entry and Check-In

Entry forms and payment must be completed and submitted to Fair Office (Monday – Thursday from 08:00AM – 4:00PM). Entry fee forms and entry fees can be submitted in person or mailed to: Bonner County Fairgrounds. 4203 N Boyer Rd. Sandpoint, ID 83864. Check or Cash only.

Entries close August 2, 2024.

Entries are filled on a first come-first entered basis.

Entry fee is non-refundable and must be submitted at time of entry.

Contestants on stand-by list will not be required to remit entry fee at time of entry but if drawn into competition will need to submit entry fee at time of check-in.

All contestants to include those on the standby list must check in at the Fair Office no later Between 5:00PM and 5:30P.M. on August 14, 2024.

All contestants will be weighed in the office at time of check in.

Any contestants over the maximum weight will be drawn out and entry fee will not be refunded.

Stand-by contestants will be notified at this time if they will participate or not and will be expected to remit entry fee at that time.

Parent/guardian must be present at check-in to complete all paperwork and waivers.

Contestants confirmed during check-in will receive two passes, one for the contestant and one for parent/guardian to get into the event.

Parent/guardian will be required to always be with contestant while at the arena for competition.
