### Information and Rules:

- Any and all cattle must have the proper registration papers (if needed). Proper paperwork will be turned into the Superintendent upon arrival.
- Only healthy animals will be admitted. All animals may be subject to a health inspection from a state licensed veterinarian who has the authority to deem any animal a health risk and require removal from the fairgrounds.
- Open to exhibitors 21 years old or younger.
- Cass County Fair will follow the rules set forth by the Missouri State Fair unless otherwise noted:
  - Wrist bands will not be used for approved animal care and show prep designations.
  - This is a youth show and 4-H/FFA Code of Ethics are enforced.
- Market Steers must be born on/after January 1, 2023.
- Market animals will be shown by weight.
- Market heifers cannot show in the breeding show.
- Breeding females will be shown by breed and age.
- Cow/calf pairs will show in their respective breed in the breeding female show. If the cow/calf pair is chosen as Breed Champion, they will be brought back in for the Champion Drive to represent their respective breed.
  - A calf that is part of a cow/calf pair cannot be shown in a heifer calf class and then compete in the cow/calf pair class.
- All cattle will be released at the completion of the show.
- Classes may be combined at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- Three entries required to show as a breed.

- Livestock exhibitors must be on hand to show their livestock. If the exhibitor has more than one animal in the same class, another youth may exhibit their animal.
- Limited electricity is available, generators are welcome.
- Stalling animals in the provided area (barn/tent) is suggested for exhibition purposes, but will not be required due to limited space.
- Bedding will not be supplied.
- Please remove all bedding at the completion of the show
- All stalls must be cleaned before being released by the Superintendent.

102: Cow/Calf Pair Pairs will show within their respective breed in the breeding female show

#### Breeding Classes - Bulls

103: Junior Bull Calf Born 07/01/23 or after  
104: Senior Bull Calf Born 1/1/23 to 6/30/23

#### Market Classes

All Market classes will be determined by weight on the day of the show. Market Heifers/ Steers must be weighed in the morning of the show to be able to participate in the class.

105: Market Steer/Heifer (All Market animals must be born after 1/1/23.)
