Information and Rules:

- Any out of state exhibitor must have health papers the day of the show.
- Only healthy animals will be admitted. All animals may be subject to a health inspection from a state licensed veterinarian who has the authority to deem any animal a health risk and require removal from the fairgrounds.
- Open to exhibitors 21 years old or younger.
- Cass County Fair will follow the rules set forth by the Missouri State Fair unless otherwise noted:
 - Wrist bands will not be used for approved animal care and show prep designations.
 - This is a youth show and 4-H/FFA Code of Ethics are enforced.
- Judging will be in accordance to the American Boer Goat Association Standards.
- Market Goats must be under one (1) year of age and have milk teeth.
- All goats will be released at the completion of the show. (Please be considerate of the sheep exhibitors. Their show is immediately following the goat show.)
- Classes may be combined at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- Limited electricity is available, generators are welcome.
- Bedding will not be supplied. All stalls must be cleaned before being released by the Superintendent.

Per Head Entry: \$5.00 by July 1, 2024,
\$10.00 after July 1, 2024
