Exterior quality, size - medium for variety, color, uniformity shape, shell texture, and condition.

*Each exhibitor must designate the particular premium for which he is competing in special classes and see that the packages are properly tagged.

*Single specimens may not be considered or shown in variety classes.

*Premiums will be awarded only when the exhibit complies with the standard, is meritorious, and is properly named.

*All exhibits entered in this department must be the product of and owned by exhibitor.

*All entries must be grown or produced by exhibitor.
