





2025 TRAVIS SEAWRIGHT SR. AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship award program is designed to recognize outstanding accomplishments of FFA or 4-H exhibitors showing animals raised for food production such as beef, dairy, swine, goats, rabbits and poultry in the Animal Science/Livestock Division of the 2025 Manatee County Fair.

Applicants eligible for consideration must be a 2025 high school or home school graduating senior intending to pursue an agricultural-related degree or certification

This program awards up to two \$1000 scholarships. The scholarship committee will determine how many scholarships will be given, depending on quality and number of applicants. This award will be paid directly to and administered by the educational institution selected by the applicant for tuition and/or fees such as university/college housing, books, food program, or other educational cost. This scholarship is to be used within 1-year of the date of the award presentation. Should a time extension be required, a request must be submitted to the Manatee River Fair Association by letter. Failure to submit this written request will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship award.

 - d. applicant's educational and professional goals and objectives set forth for his/her post high school educational opportunities.
- Three letters of recommendation from the following:
 - 1. Applicant's FFA advisor or 4-H club project leader,
 - 2. An individual who personally knows the applicant and can attest to their character, and
 - 3. Organization or agency representative who can attest to applicant's voluntary involvement in community activities.
