Guidelines

The Hampshire Franklin & Hampden Agricultural Society (Three County Fair) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization whose mission is “to promote agriculture, agricultural education, and agricultural science in the Commonwealth.”

Under our Scholarship Program, we offer multiple scholarships each year to graduating seniors attending a high school in a city or town of Franklin, Hampshire and Hampden, MA counties.

Priority is given to graduating seniors who are pursuing a career in agriculture, agricultural experience, including exhibiting or volunteering at the Three County Fair, a record of volunteerism in their community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extra-curricular school activities.

Applicants should be planning to attend a two or four year college or technical school.

Applicants are encouraged to submit additional forms with their application such as an essay, letter of recommendation, and/or resume.

Scholarships are paid during the student’s first year directly to the college and not the student. It will be the student’s responsibility to submit a copy of their school’s tuition & fees invoice with student ID number and college information.

Applications must be completed and include the student’s most recent school transcript.

Application deadline is Friday, April 1, 2022 by 4:00pm to be received by the Three County Fair. Late applications are not accepted.
