RULES FOR DRAFT HORSE TEAMSTER'S CHALLENGE

- Teamsters will earn points for completing obstacles cleanly and within specific boundaries.
- The team's behavior, presentation, and responsiveness to the driver will also earn points.
- Points will be deducted for incomplete obstacles.
- Timing will be factored in if a tie breaker is necessary.
- Coggins and current Health Certificate must be presented.
- Teams can be used by different drivers.
- No Driver can compete more than 1 time per class.

Class

- 01. Obstacle Course: complete obstacles using a cart or sled.
- 02. Log Scoot: complete obstacles that replicate logging with horses.
- 03. Draft Barrel Race: Ride your draft horse/pony around the barrels. Teamster and horse may only compete once.
- 04. Judge's Choice: if the judge chooses to run this class, they will design a challenge of their choice.
