

Auditions are open to the public; all roles are open. For auditions, please prepare 32 bars of a song that showcases your voice. Please bring an instrumental accompaniment track to sing along to. Be prepared to learn four 8-counts of dance if the role you are auditioning for requires it. Actors may be asked to read a portion of the script. Rehearsals will begin the end of June. Please bring a list of all potential conflicts for July, August and September. You are encouraged to provide a resume of your onstage experience. Auditions are first-come first-served each day and sign up begins 15 minutes prior to the start time.

Cathy Koncurat is the director of the musical, which will be performed September 16-18th and 23-25th. The musical director is Lashelle Bray. Leslie Perry is the choreographer, and Emily Jewett is the stage manager.
