



KNOXVILLE CIVIC COLISEUM TECHNICAL PACKET

The Knoxville Civic Auditorium-Coliseum is located at:

500 Howard Baker Jr. Avenue Knoxville, TN 37915.

The Civic Coliseum is the largest performance and event space in the KCAC multipurpose complex. The coliseum provides seating for up to 6,500 guests and more than 20,000 square feet of exhibit space. The stage and seating capacities are flexible to meet the needs of your event or performance. The coliseum includes a curtain that can divide the space into condensed seating configurations to accommodate smaller events. The coliseum also features an ice chiller plant that can transform the facility into an ice rink for performances and hockey games.

DIRECTIONS TO LOADING AREA

From: (I-75 North and South/I-40 East)

I-40 East to Exit #389, Broadway/Hall of Fame. Turn right onto Hall of Fame Drive. Turn left at the fifth spotlight onto Howard Baker Jr. Avenue. Take your first right onto Honor Our Troops Drive. Take your first right onto Historic Preservation Drive. After passing the parking garage and overhead pedestrian walkway, take a right on the road labeled stage entrance. Keep left and proceed down the hill.

From: (I-40 Westbound)

I-40 West to Exit #388, James White Parkway. Take James White Parkway to Hill Avenue/Riverside Drive. Exit at spotlight, turn left onto Hill Avenue. Take first left onto Historic Preservation Drive. After passing the parking garage and overhead pedestrian walkway, take a right on the road labeled stage entrance. Keep left and proceed down the hill.

SPACE

- 106 x 198-foot cement arena floor
- 85 x 180-foot wide ice rink for performances and hockey

RECEPTION HALL

- The 4,800 square foot reception hall hosts meetings, weddings, and corporate and community events. The 52-foot-by-90 foot space easily accommodates 250 guests for a catered meal; 400 guests for theater seating; and 150 for schoolroom seating. This space is located on the third floor, is accessible by elevator or stairs, and is often used as a pre-function space.

LOAD-IN INFORMATION

- Drive-through loading area that can fit one truck easily, two trucks if needed. Must unload with forklift or truck ramps.
- 20 ft push to typical stage location.

BUS PARKING

- Bus parking should be advanced with your event manager prior to arrival.
- Multiple shore power locations

POWER

- Four 400-AMP 3 phase disconnects, upstage left.
- One 200-AMP 3 phase disconnects, upstage left
- One 150-AMP cam lock, catering area

STAGE

- Moveable Stage Right rolling stage with flexible configurations up to 3,136 square feet of space. Standard size stage is 60 x 40 feet. Maximum size stage is 60 x 56 feet.
- In-house rails, skirting, and up to four sets of stairs
- 80' of Mojo style barricade

LIGHTING AVAILABLE

- (4) Brand: Lycian (1290 XLT 2-K) Xenon Spots located on the north end (center of room) of the coliseum – two above Section BB and two above section DD
- (2) Brand: Lycian (1275 Spot lights, 100 to 450 feet of throw distance) can be set up on the east and west sides of the coliseum in the last two rows of sections F, D, N and Q. These spotlights are temporary/removable.
- House lighting system includes customizable lighting schemes and color-changing capabilities

HAZE/FIRE WATCH

- The Knoxville Fire Department (KFD) determines the need for standby fire watch/crowd management while the facility is open to registrants or the public. Fire watch is always required if haze is used during production. Lessee is responsible for all related charges.

SCOREBOARD

- Four-sided center-hung scoreboard which can be hoisted upon client request. May also be utilized for tie-in purposes for additional fee.

RIGGING

- Rigging plot available upon request

DRESSING ROOMS

- Three locker rooms with restrooms and showers.
- Four individual star rooms with restrooms and showers.
- One catering rooms with seating for 40.

LABOR UNION RATES/RULES

- IATSE Local Union 197 rates and rules available upon request

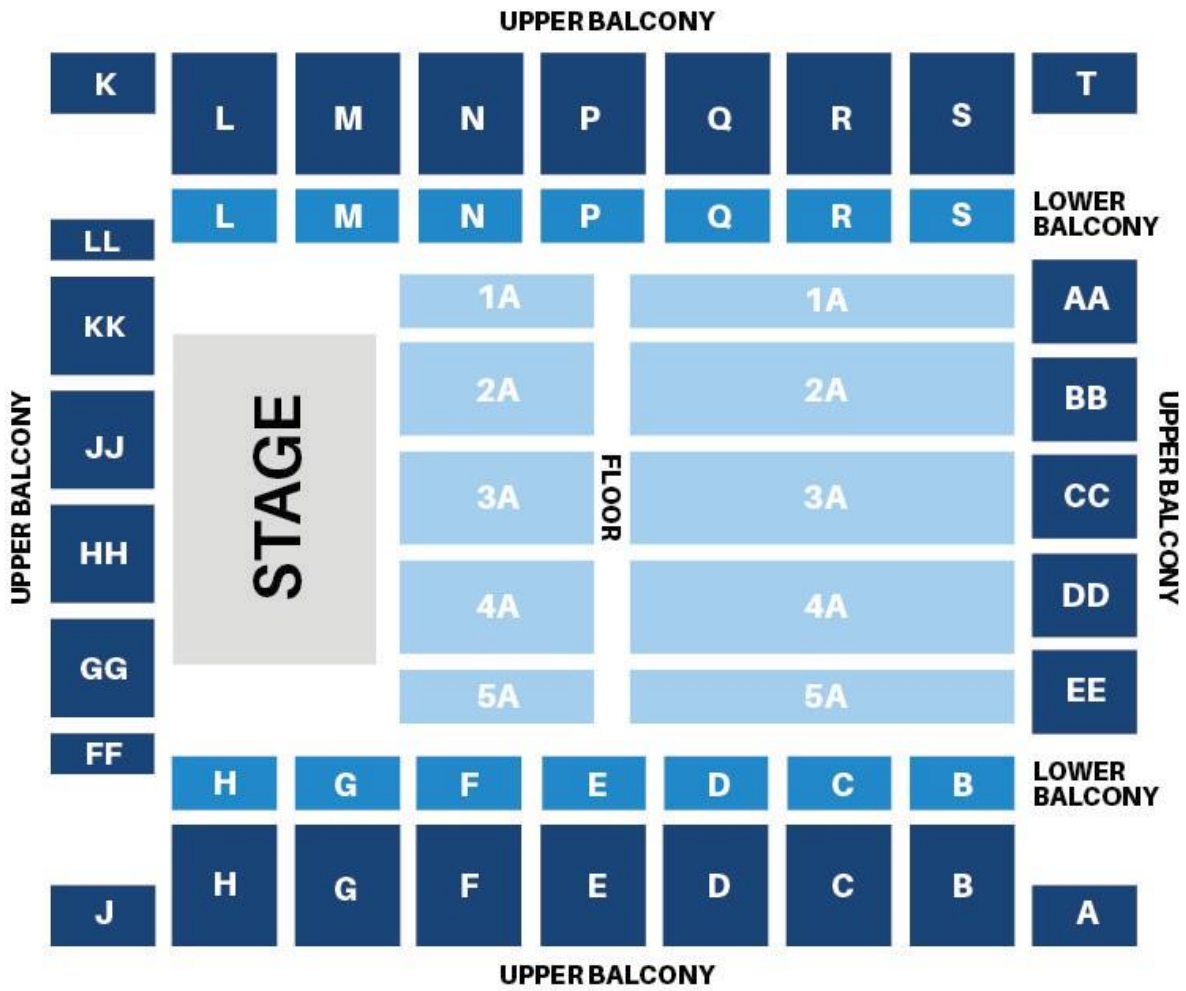
MERCHANDISE

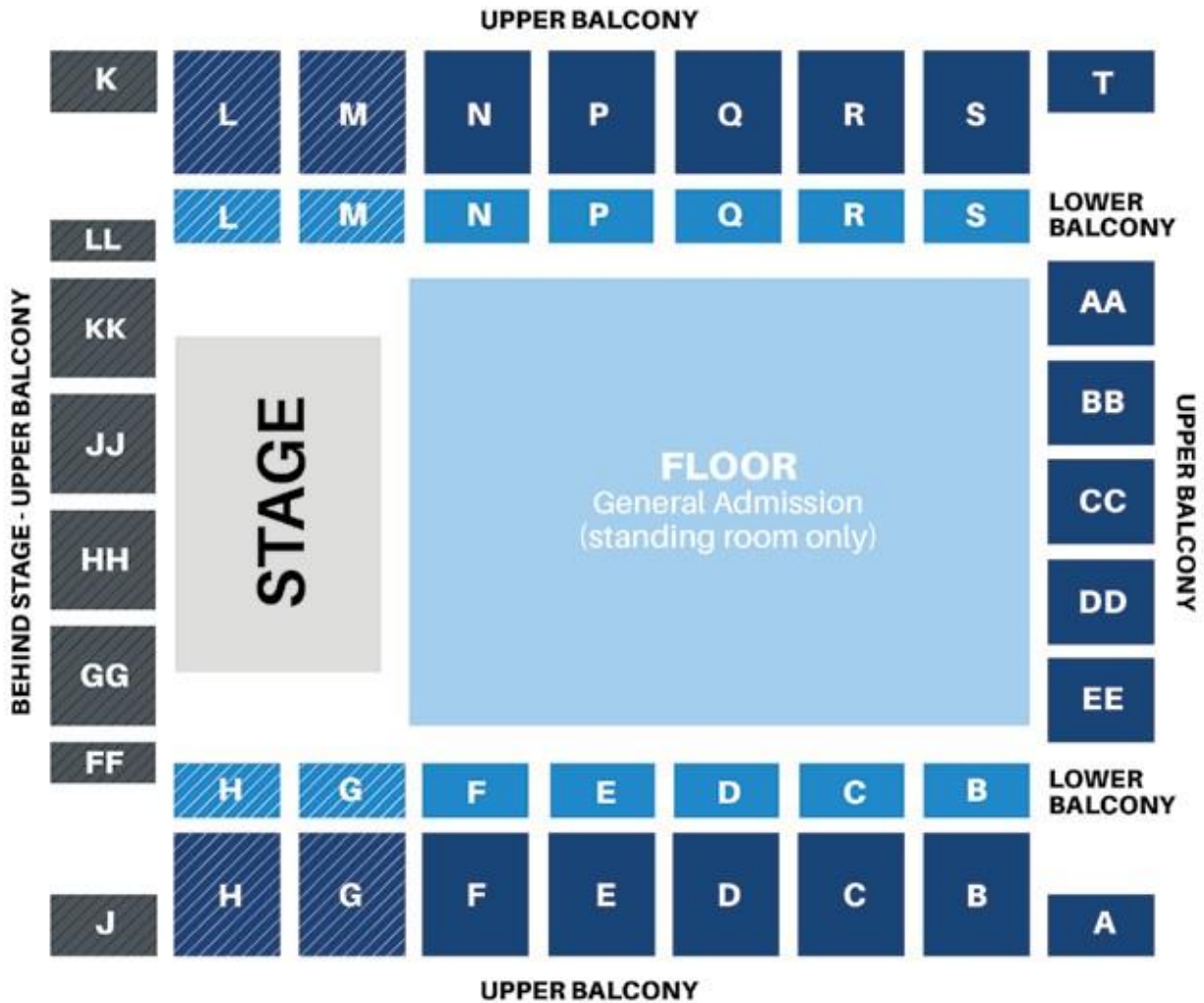
