A. Moore Engineering Update

Tyson Hajicek of Moore Engineering presented to council the future of projects within the City of Ada and what the council can expect from the State and Federal Governments and their requirements for infrastructure projects. Mr. Hajicek pointed out that two projects have been on the docket, the sewer collection project and the Rage addition. The sewer rehab project is a future 2023 IEP project with funds coming from the new Build Back Better infrastructure dollars being distributed by the federal government. Tyson wanted to know from council how they may want to proceed as a city.

Motion made by Member Nelson and seconded by Member Mathsen to approve that Moore Engineering come back to council with an engineering proposal to continue moving forward with projects. Members for: Nelson, Erickson, Mathsen, and Roux. Opposed NONE Motion passes

A. Mayors Report

1) 2022 Elections

Mayor Hintz stated that 4 council seats and the mayor's seat is open for election in 2022. Applications to run for election for these seats will be available in early August.

2) Committee Members – Will appoint in February

Mayor Hintz updated council on committees and that community members are needed to participate and be a part of the five committees and share their concerns, expertise and solutions within these committees. Committee members will be assigned by Mayor Hintz before the February regular meeting.

B. Administrator / Clerk / Treasurer Report.

- 1) Department Updates
 - a. Dekko Hot Tub

Administrator Larson updated council on the happenings within the departments in the City of Ada. An ice rink liner was installed recently, with the help of a number of volunteers coming out to assist with this project. A huge thank you from Manager Eggen and Administrator Larson to the volunteers who helped.

Larson's next item of concern for the Dekko Center was the hot tub. A new heater for the hot tub is being installed soon and the hot tub should be up and running when complete. The steam room is still not operating and an estimate to fix it is very expensive. This will be a topic of discussion at future council meetings. Swimming lessons, weight loss challenge and other winter activities are ongoing this winter. Staffing is still a concern.

Administrator Larson went on to discuss what was keeping Public Works busy and that is snow removal. Cleaning streets and moving snow to dump sites have been the norm. The snow emergency and vehicle towing ordinance has been addressed and a reminder to citizens has been a constant to enforce the ordinance.

Larson went on to discuss the happenings at the liquor store. Sales were great in the month of December. End of the year inventory was taken at the end of December and final numbers for 2021 will be complete at the time of the audit.

The police department concerns are ongoing with Chief Bueng and being able to cover his shifts as he is still unable to return to work after COVID complications. The main officers have taken on extra duties as well as the sheriff's department to cover these hours.

Administrator Larson updated council regarding the approval of the Housing Rehabilitation Grant. The City of Ada has made it through the first round of approval and are awaiting the final round, which is anticipated by March or April.
