1) Department Updates

Administrator Larson updated council about activities with the different departments in the City. Final audit documents were sent out. Special audits were needed for our Bonded Projects. Summer hours will go into effect starting May 1st. Hours will be 7:30am to 5:30pm Monday thru Thursday and 8:00am to Noon on Friday. The Dekko Center is gearing up to a busy spring and summer. Brianna Eggen headed up a tree planting project tied into Arbor Day, with youth assisting in the planting. Swim lessons will be starting soon. The annual bike rodeo is set for May 5th , after school is let out. Public works has been assisting with the Dekko Center and is gearing up for their summer schedule. The Liquor Store has seen a decline in revenue as compared to the prior year. Manager Aasland has been planning tastings of new product and other specials are being planned to hopefully bring more business to the Liquor Store.

RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO THE GRANTING OF A LEASHOLD MORTGAGE

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ada, Minnesota, as follows:

Section 1. Definitions. The capitalized terms used in this resolution have the meanings assigned below:

2021 Bonds: means DEDA's revenue bonds, proposed to be issued in one or more series in an aggregate maximum principal amount of not to exceed \$150,000,000.

Authorized Officers: means the Mayor and Administrator of the City.

Bond Counsel to DEDA: means Fryberger, Buchanan, Smith & Frederick, P.A.

BCC: means Bridges Care Center.

Benedictine: means Benedictine Health System d/b/a Benedictine, the sole member of the BCC.

City: means the City of Ada, Minnesota.

City Council: means the governing body of the City.

DEDA: means the Duluth Economic Development Authority, St. Louis County, Minnesota.

Prior Bonds: means the City's Multifamily Housing Development Revenue Note, Series 2012A (Bridges Care Center Project), dated August 17, 2012.

Project: means the assisted living facilities located at 201 Ninth Street West, Ada, Minnesota, by BCC.

Section 2. General Recitals.

A. The City and BCC previously entered into that Lease and Development Agreement, which is evidenced by a Memorandum of Lease and Development Agreement dated August 17, 2012, and recorded in the office of the Norman County Recorder on August 17, 2012, as Document No. 224621 (the "Lease"), pursuant to which BCC leases land on which it operates the Project.

B. The Prior Bonds were issued to finance the Project, and payment of the Prior Bonds was secured, in part, by a mortgage (the "2012 Mortgage").

C. The City's \$540,000 Multifamily Housing Development Revenue Note, Series 2012B (Bridges Care Center Project), issued on the same date as the Prior Bonds have been paid in full.

D. The proceeds of the 2021 Bonds will be used, in part, to refinance the Prior Bonds.

E. Benedictine will cause 17 of its affiliates to form an obligated group, including BCC (the "Obligated Group"), by entering into a Master Trust Indenture between Benedictine as Obligated Group Agent, the members of the Obligated Group and U.S. Bank National Association as the master trustee (the "Master Indenture").

F. Each of the members of the Obligated Group, including BCC, will deliver or join in a mortgage to secure payment of the 2021 Bonds and other obligations of the members of the Obligated Group under the Master Indenture.

G. Section 15(D) of the Lease requires that the City consent prior to BCC mortgaging its interests in the Land (as defined in the Lease).

H. The form of Leasehold Mortgage, Security Agreement and Assignment of Leases and Rents to be given by BCC is attached hereto as Exhibit A. The new mortgage will replace the 2012 Mortgage.

Section 3. Consent and Approval. The City consents to BCC mortgaging its interest in the Land. The form of mortgage attached as Exhibit A is approved with such changes as may be approved by the Authorized Officers.

Section 4. Authorization to Staff. The Authorized Officers and other officers of the City (individually or with one or more other officers of the City or their designees) are authorized and directed to (a) provide a certified copy of this resolution to BCC or its representatives, along with all proceedings and records of the City relating to the subject matter of this resolution, and any other affidavits and certificates required by Bond Counsel to DEDA to show the facts relating to the City respecting the subject matter of this resolution, and (b) take any other action, including approvals, consents and certificates, required or deemed appropriate on the request of Bond Counsel to DEDA or its agents for performance of the City in connection with the subject matter of this resolution.
