Exhibitor & Lamb Information: Information to fill in the record book.

<u>Feed Summary</u>: Feed summary is to be completed accurately to the best of your ability.

<u>Written Responses:</u> Your answers are complete sentences with correct and proper spelling and grammar. The individual will be judged on the content and the terminology used to efficiently answer the question.

<u>Total Expenses:</u> This will have the most variance between the participants. Everyone has a different situation, set-up and program.

Legible: Legibility is important for easy reading and minimizing any confusion.

<u>Completeness:</u> All questions and information are answered and completed. Supporting documents are present and encouraged: (pictures, any and all sponsor communication and any documents throughout your Lamb Challenge experience).

- 5. What were your top three greatest problems you dealt with when raising your lamb? Rank them one being largest problem, three being lesser of a problem. Please expand on each problem with why it was a challenge and how you overcame it.
- **6.** How do you interpret today's sheep industry?
- **7.** As a youth sheep exhibitor, describe what you can do or how you can help educate consumers about the food safety of sheep and sheep products. (Give examples, if applicable)
- **8.** React to the question "What are the benefits of being involved in youth livestock activities?"
- **9.** How do you think the experiences you have been through with your youth activities will help you in the future?
