



## 2023 AKSARBEN STOCK SHOW – LIVESTOCK INTERN

### Position Description

The livestock internship for Aksarben is geared towards those applicants interested in learning how to work, manage and execute livestock shows at an elite level. The position will report directly to the Agriculture Director, Aksarben Stock Show Manager, and Aksarben Stock Show Coordinator.

A successful candidate will be enrolled in an agriculture-related major. They will be excellent at oral and written communication. The applicant will be a self-starter with minimal supervision and maximum production. They will have great organization skills and be very detail oriented.

**Time Period: total of 8 working days; September 17<sup>th</sup> – September 24<sup>th</sup>**

- The intern will be expected to work the complete duration of the Aksarben event including weekend days and evening hours.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Office and customer service
- Pre-show correspondence
- Entry management
- Compile information for packets for species (Goats, Sheep, Beef, Swine)
- Assist with Springboard signage
- Event Planning
- Assist division and department superintendents
- Assist with duties associated with the Check-in Trailer
- Assist with award organization and distribution of awards during/at shows
- Clerking Shows
- Show program processing, final results, data inputting, etc.
- Additional duties as determined by supervisor.

### Requirements:

- Candidate must be a collegiate sophomore or older at the time of Aksarben 2023 (can be a current freshman at the time of applying)
- Selected intern cannot be an exhibitor or competitor at the 2023 Aksarben
- Candidate must have a stock show background.
