#### **Visitors with Disabilities**

#### **Uptown Festival Parking**

Parking for the Barbecue Festival is located throughout Uptown Lexington in private parking lots. Parking lots are operated by community groups with most charging a daily fee to park.

Important! We urge you not to park on side streets or alleys surrounding the festival. Vehicles parked illegally WILL be towed.

While at the festival, please plan to stop by the Childress Vineyards booth, located at the square, to purchase Fine Swine Wine.




