## **Visitors with Disabilities**

A parking lot reserved for vehicles with handicapped permits is located on State Street, between 2nd Street and 3rd Street. State Street runs parallel with Main Street.

### **Uptown Festival Parking**

Parking for the Barbecue Festival is located throughout Uptown Lexington in private parking lots. Parking lots are operated by community groups with most charging a daily fee to park.

Important! We urge you not to park on side streets or alleys surrounding the festival. Vehicles parked illegally WILL be towed.

The Piedmont, originating from Raleigh, and the Carolinian, originating from Charlotte, will be making their once-a-year stops in Lexington for the Barbecue Festival. While at the festival, please plan to stop by the Childress Vineyards booth, located at the square, to purchase Fine Swine Wine.




