

Bedford County Junior Livestock Sale Scholarship Application

General Requirements

- Normally, you must sell an animal through the junior livestock sale at the Bedford County Fair during the year in which you apply. (For example, for 2021, you must have sold an animal through the sale in 2021.)
- You must be enrolled in a post secondary education program and must attach proof of enrollment to this form. (copy of tuition bill, I.D. card, or class schedule)
- Scholarship amount will be prorated based on the number of years selling a market animal (up to four years) and the amount of funds available for a given year.
- Application forms are due in the Extension Office, 120 W. John Street, Suite 2, Bedford, PA 15522 no later than October 15 of the current year.
- Scholarships will be issued around January 1 of of the following year.
- **You may only receive this scholarship one time.**
